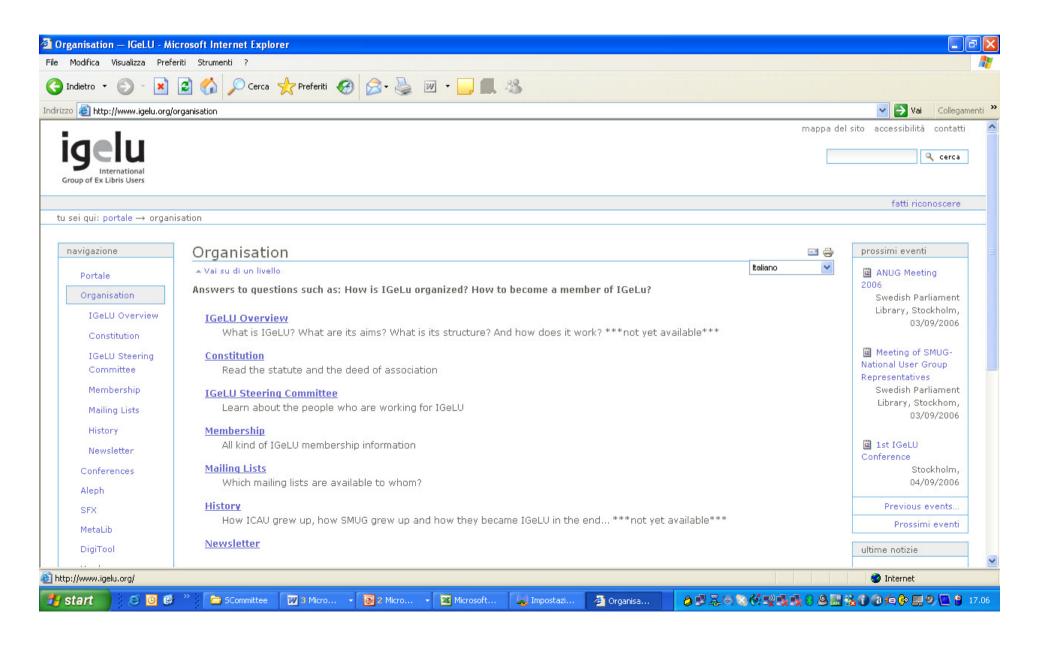


4. documentation centre

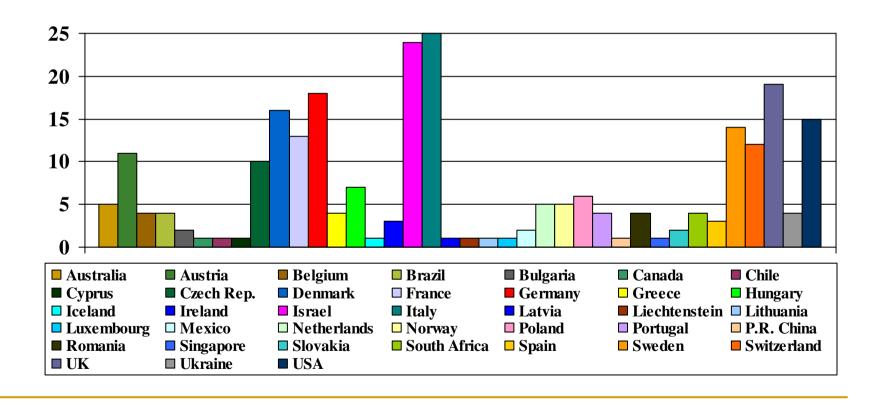

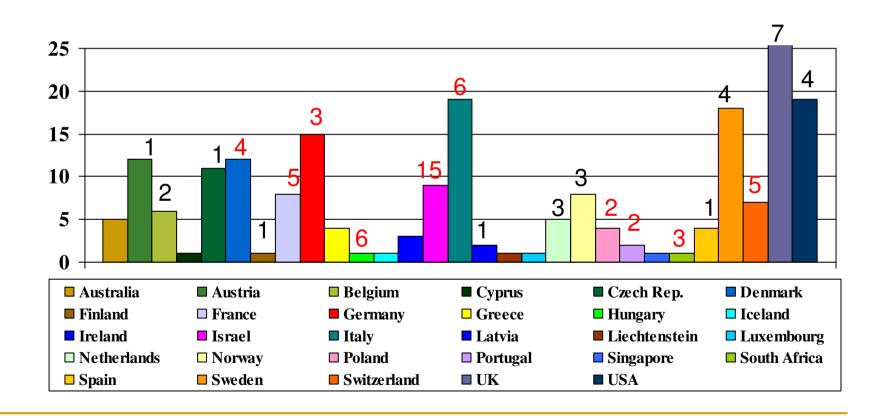

IGeLU members in 2006



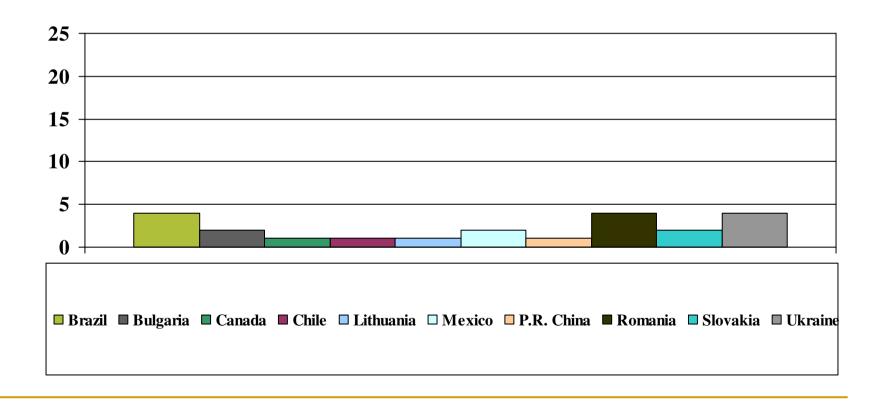

IGeLU budget



- According to the interim Steering Committee proposal, the draft budget for the coming year includes many expenses that we deem necessary in order to support activities and some facetoface meetings of the SC and PWG, even if we think that most work will be done via e-mail or conference call.
- This has to be seen as a draft budget drawn up according to prudential criteria and we haven't planned to have a balance between revenues and expenditures since at the moment an exhaustive estimation of the Association is not available.
- The annual fee for 2007 will not be increased.
