  - Easy to use, easy to access, open to all customers (→ authentication issue!)

- Ex Libris gives technical support
- The wiki is part of EL COMMONS
- EL COMMONS is: our wiki + a Developer Zone
- The wiki content is managed by IGeLU + ELUNA
- The wiki is open to all (!) customers
- The content belongs to the user community

---

- For each product there is a section
- Each section is strongly interlinked with the Developer Zone (software)
- Features of a modern wiki
  - Powerful editor
  - Alerting, RSS-Feeds
  - Tagging, Commenting functionality
  - Personal spaces

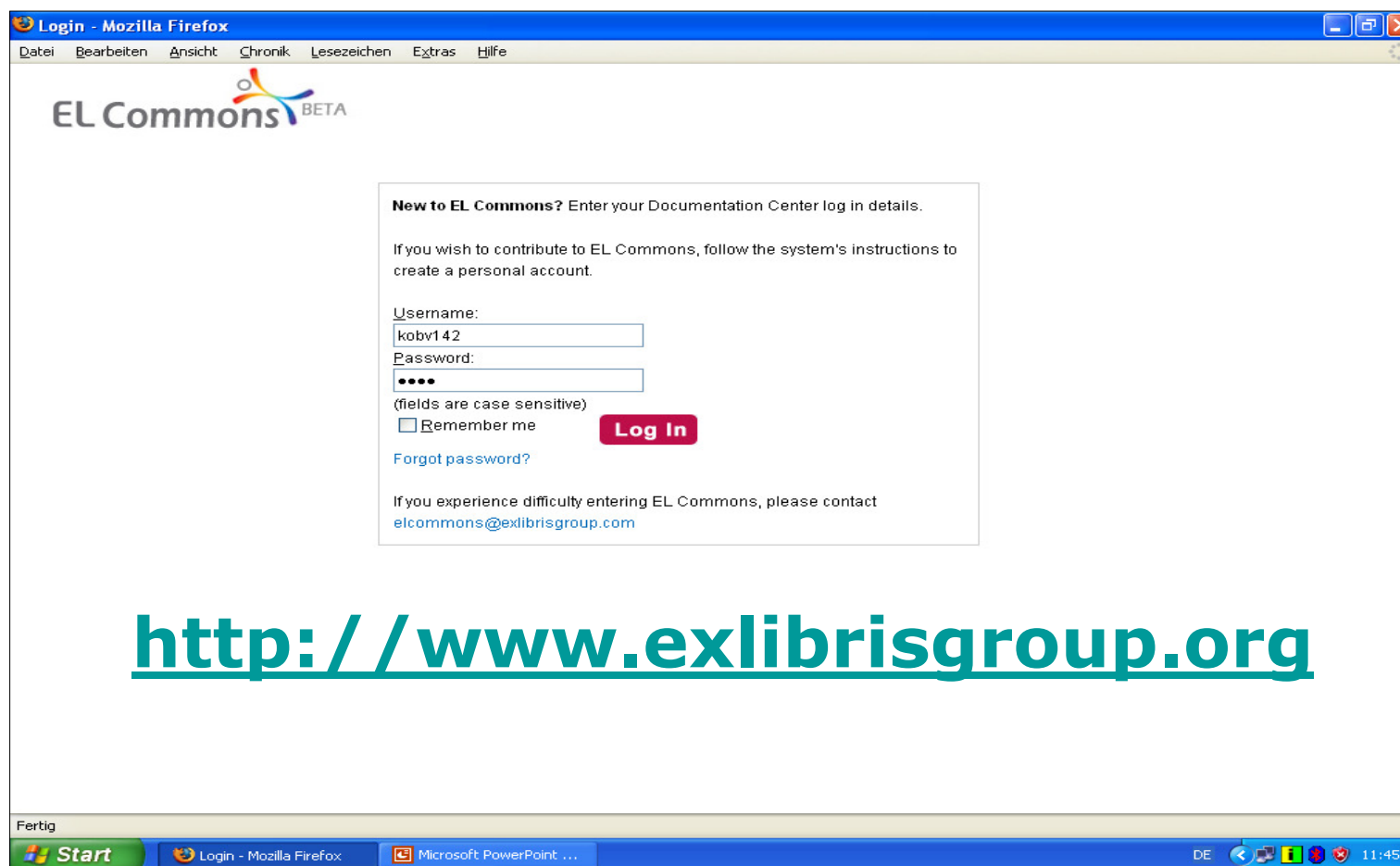
