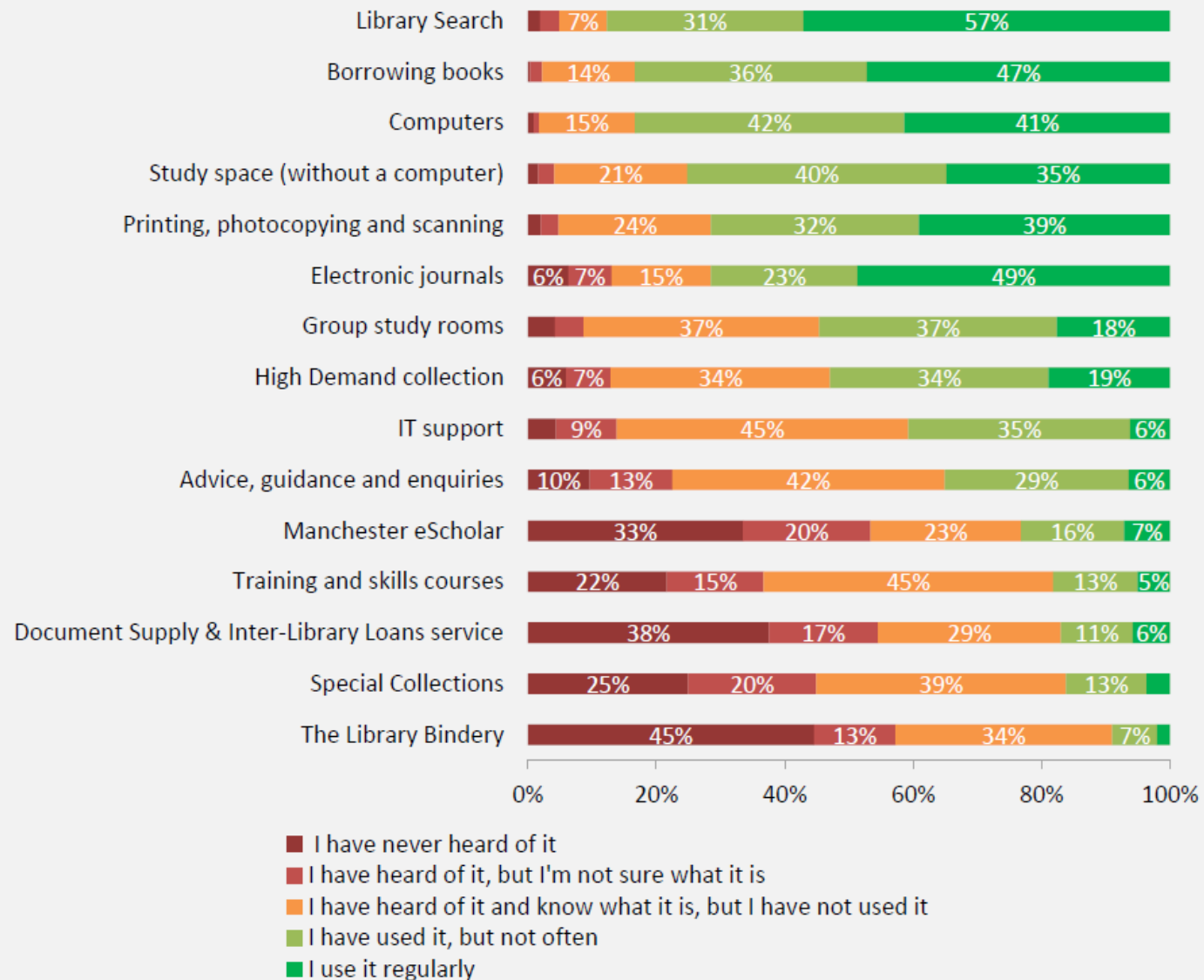

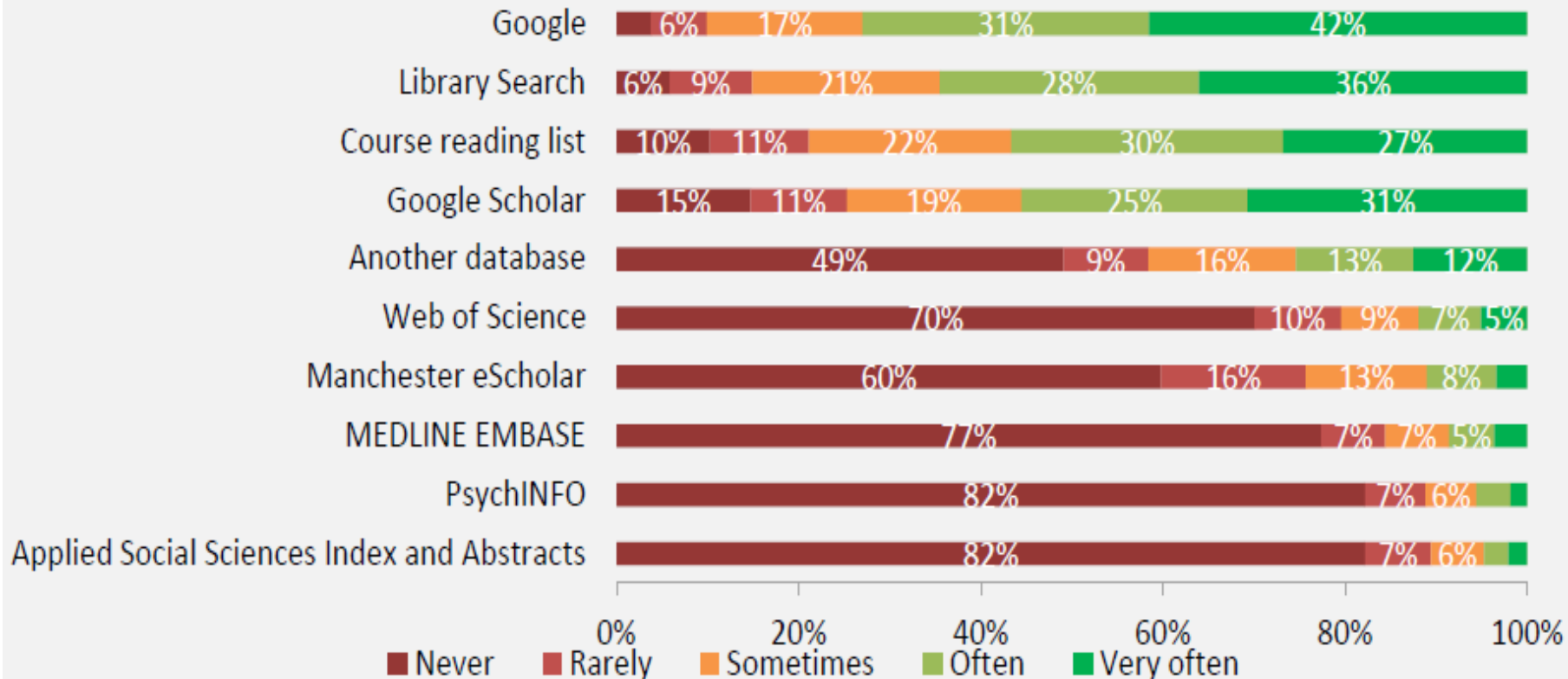


## What tools do you use when looking for relevant content?

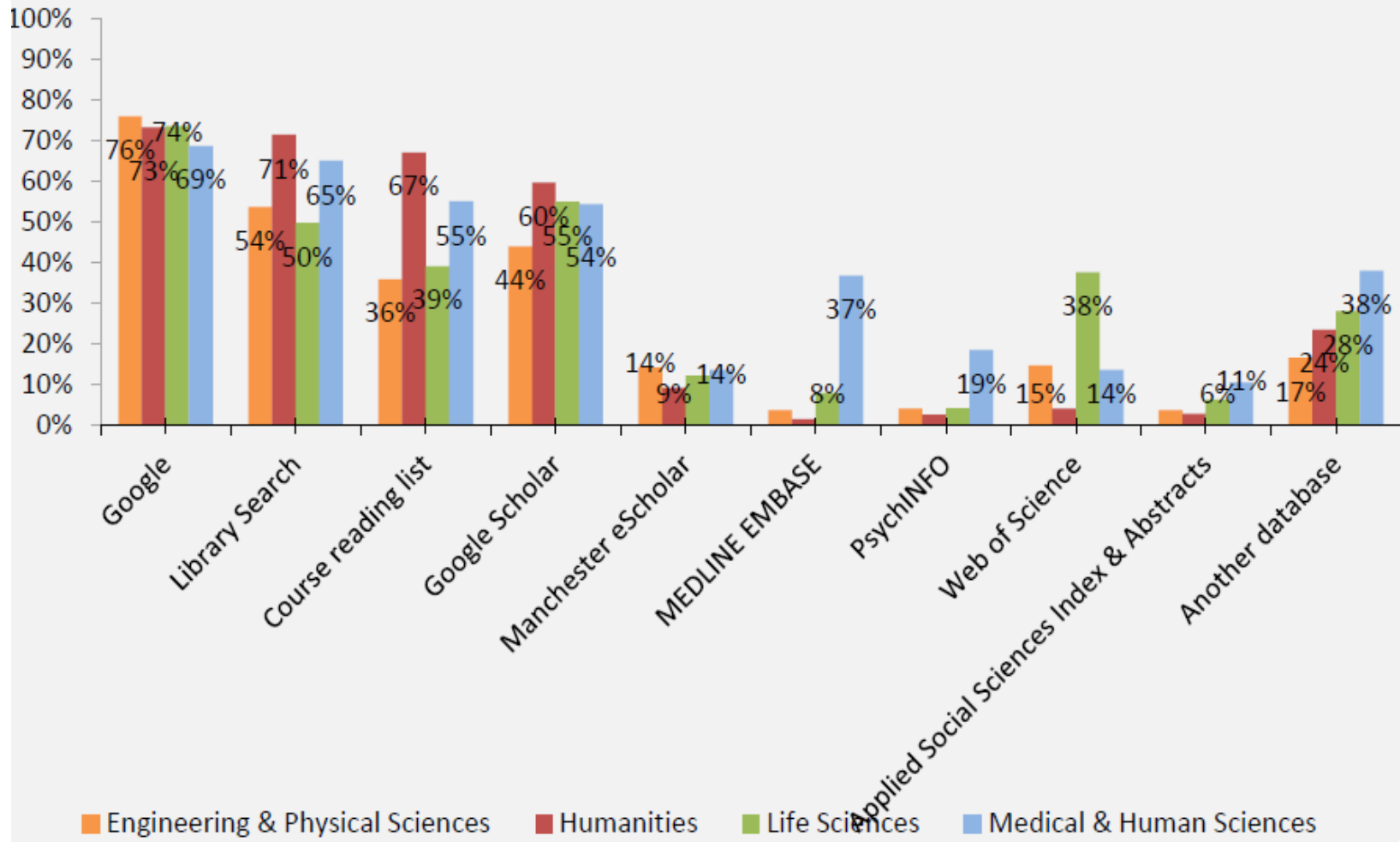

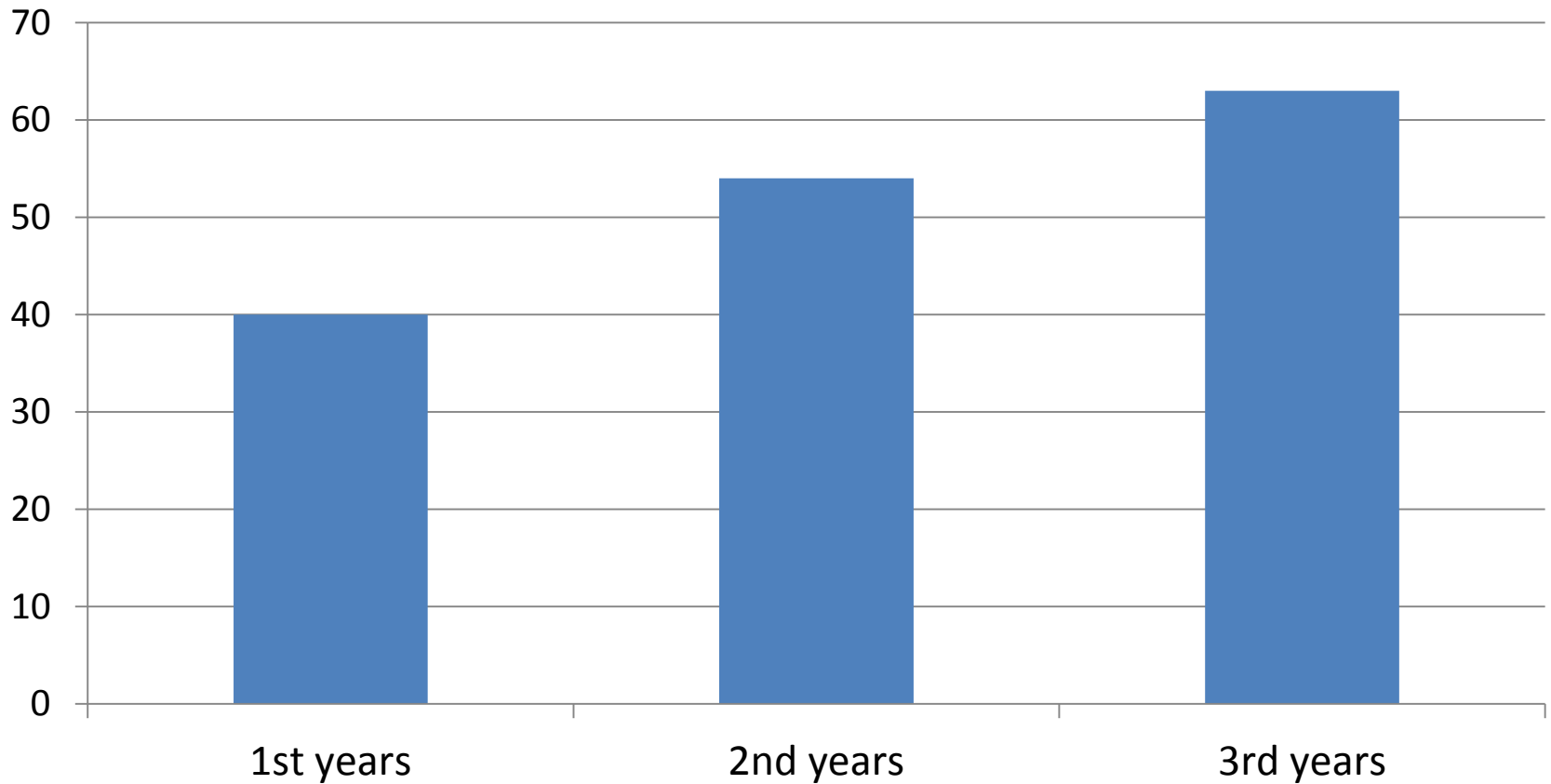

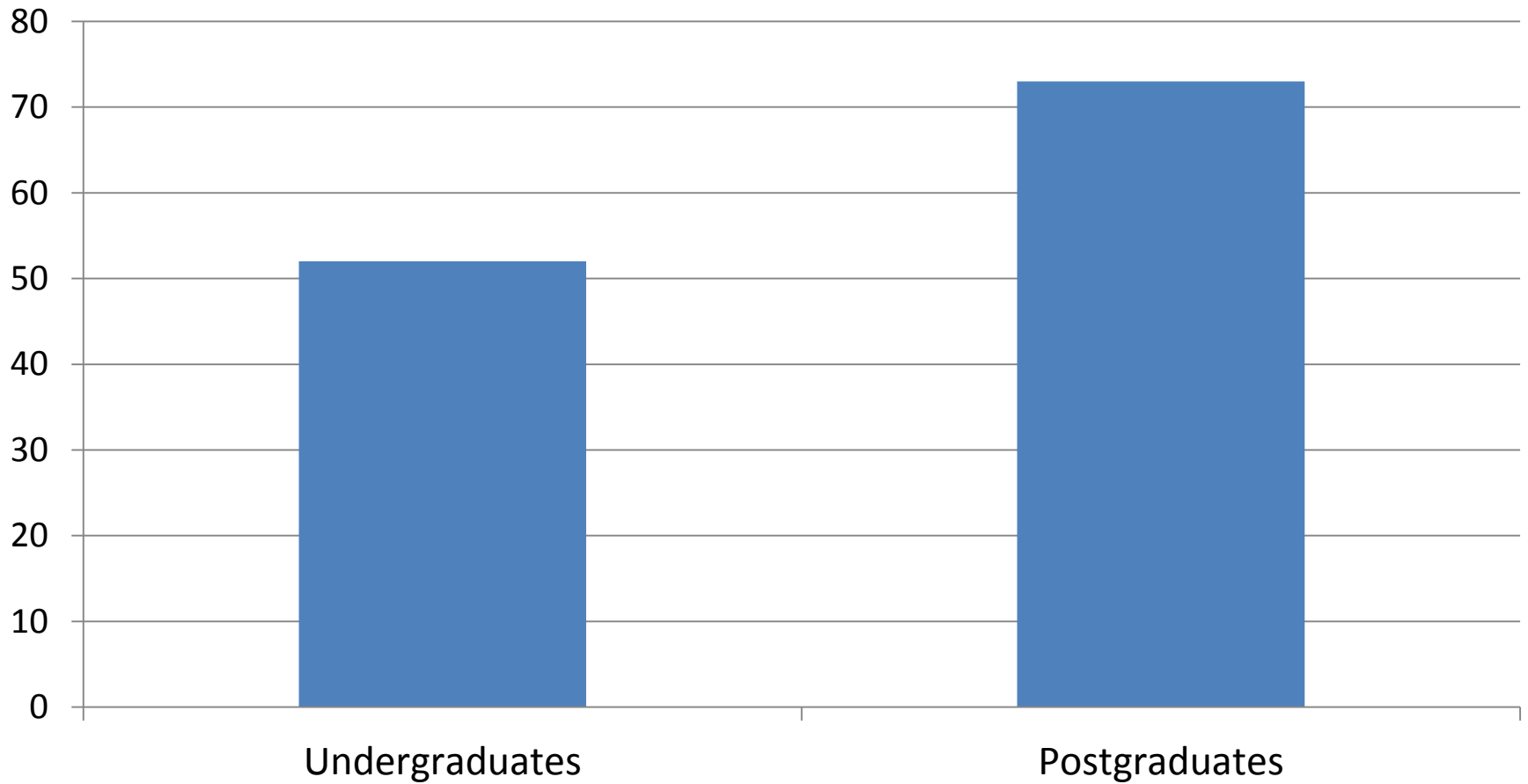

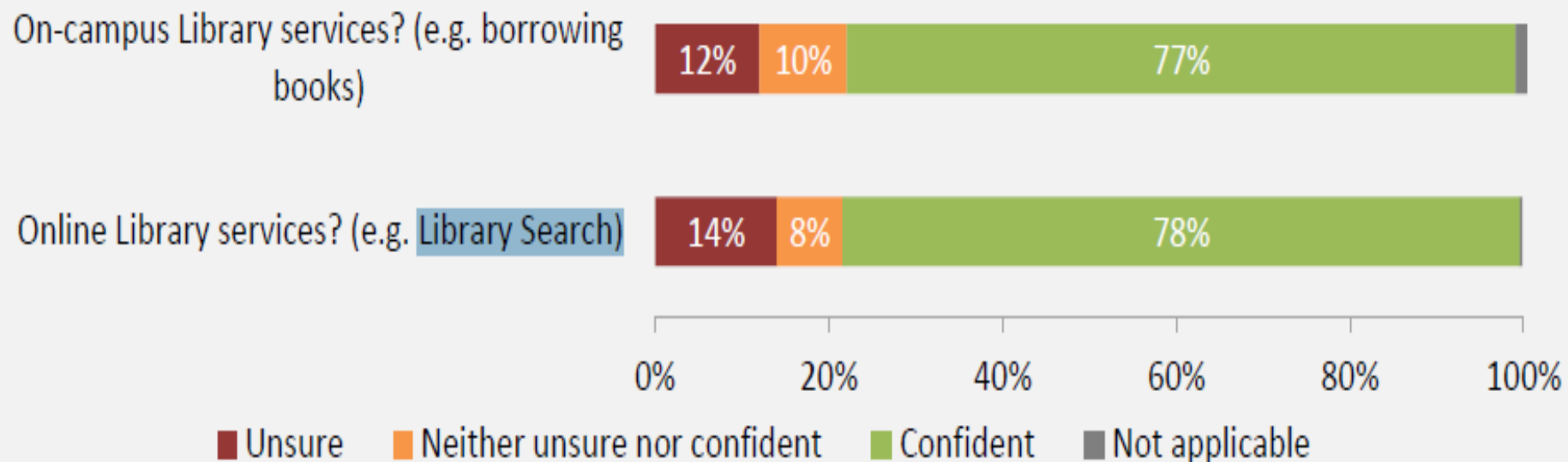
