We are interested in users' experiences of **Alma; Aleph and ARC; Voyager; Discovery Solutions (Primo, Primo Central Index, MetaLib, MetaLib+); SFX and bX; Verde and UStat; DigiTool and Rosetta, Leganto, CampusM, Intota, Summon, SIPX, 360 link.**

Proposals may also cover topics that relate to the wider development of library and information systems within the context of ExLibris products, e.g.:

- Innovative use of products
- Integration of products with each other or with external systems
- Innovation in interfaces: accessible, mobile, something completely different?
- Experiences with new products or the latest release of current ones
- Migration aspects (e.g. migration to Alma)
- ExLibris hosted/cloud solution - how is it working for you; how has it changed your work?
- Authentication and authorization, e.g., PDS, Single Sign On, Shibboleth
- Optimizing systems and maximizing resources
- Knowledge base related experience
- Consortia issues
