I am a former director of library information systems for Hamilton College in New York USA of 15 years, with Voyager as the main product.

I attended what is now ELUNA as a member, presenter, and developer regionally and nearly annually since 2002, and earned my Voyager Oracle certificate with David Dempsey of Endeavor, master of the DB tablespaces in the old days.

Most of my development work was in Perl and PHP on interoperability issues and pre-business logic for an improved patron experience. I was an outspoken advocate of open platform and community code sharing from the very beginning.
