
# "It just needs to say unavailable?" From DAT to API



- Due to student feedback the library decided to add a new riser into the library to solve issues with air conditioning. This mention that over two summers Level 4 and 5 was renovated in 2017 then level 1, 2 and 3 were renovated in 2018.
- I was part of a space move group to help support any changes that would affect library system.
- We have only just updated to Primo New UI in Easter of 2018.



- One of the main issues with the move, was making library books unavailable but requestable in Primo. And added enough distinct labels to make sure student where aware of the temporary changes.
- I had to put a series of examples together to explain how Primo might look. Working with the space group of librarians with differing IT knowledge. So a decision could be made on the best option.




#### Work Order Work Around

We had read the process of returning items using the Scan it in API. Where you need direct access to the route of a server to run a BASH code to return items.

We tested for a few weeks and could not get this process to work.


We was left with the choose of asking Ex Libris to return the items using the bash code. Or finding a different solution.






