My goals in the Steering Committee:

- Enhance and secure community collaboration and product customization
- Work with WGs to obtain better product documentation and communication
- Work for a common understanding with ExLibris on challenges in the enhancement process



Priorities : customizations & collaboration

I want to help ensure that products can be customized easily and reliably by individual institutions to meet their needs.

Products, as well as the community, should support an efficient collaboration infrastructure.

Good examples are the Primo New UI, the Primo Studio suite, and the community-driven Add-ons.

WGs are in the front line of this, and I want to support such efforts in the SC.



Priorities : Product communication

IGeLU leadership (SC and WG) need to help ExLibris understand the information needs and requirements of customers, and can help raise issues and advise on product communication gaps.

Sample recent issues: Alma Sandbox refresh policy, Newspaper Search, CDI rollout.

I aim to work with WGs and ExL to find better solutions for handling such cases and improve documentation in general.



Priorities : Product enhancement process

A backbone of community activity, the product enhancement process has served us well for many years.

It should be a priority for IGeLU to ensure that NERS adapts, in order to retain its efficiency, in meeting changes in company policy and new product deployment models.

Recent concerns: more ExL rejections.

Aim: analyse the problems and adjust the enhancement model to serve us better.
