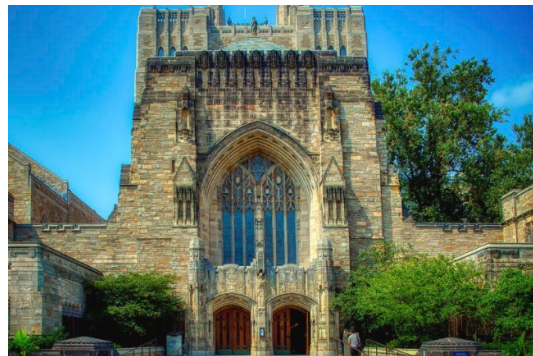

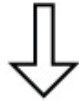
My contribution to IGeLU
