I would like to have a better Advanced Search in Acquisitions.

*By Birgit Hallerberg:*

New GOBI automatic linking: Very interesting workflow and enhancement, indeed a time saver for the acquisition process. Problem: poor metadata quality of CZ bib records.... We still go on overlaying order records for this reason

*By Susan Davis:*

I wish we had "interested user" functionality with orders for e-resources, particularly ebooks so we could notify requestors when ebook access is available.

*By Katie Lai:*

I wish we could remove “interested users” from selected POLs as we need, not a blanket removal for all cancelled/completed POLs, but specific POLs based on the criteria we set (e.g. completed within the past 3 years).

*By Charlene King:*

It would be good if we this CZ functionality was optional in Real Team Ordering- we don't want to use it and have had to construct a long-winded work around.

*By Amanda Quimby:*

I wish 'licence review' could be part of the acquisitions workflow. e.g. Set up order, review and approve licence and set up e-access.

*By Martin French:*

I would like the SUSHI harvesting to let us know if the problem with automated harvesting is a problem with our setup or with the publisher.

I would like to be able to record if VAT is applicable to the order - it is currently only available at vendor level and we now get a mix of VAT liable/non liable/partially liable from vendors with the change in UK law.

*By Chris Jones:*

Can Ex Libris give an update on Leganto-Alma Acquisitions workflows (might be Tamar/Dolav also?) - bringing Rialto and recent enhancements together has been complicated, and establishing "best practice" tricky!

*By François Renaville:*

The ERP Number cannot be searched in the UI, it is not indexed. Since it can be very important for some institutions (notably in communication with vendors), this is very annoying for the Acquisition team.
