<b>Question</b>	<b>Answers</b>
Please make the data in the TR_J4 report accessible for analysis so we can see our archive usage.	There is currently an issue with TR_J4 reports harvested from JUSP (aggregator) - this is being analyzed with the vendor. On case there are other vendors which has similar issue please submit a ticket with ExLibris support.
Does Alma also sync stats via SUSHI (if a vendor re-states their statistics for a given month)?	Alma looks internally at the previously harvested reports and their specific month before harvesting usage data from the vendor, Alma will not attempt to harvest any report which was previously harvested. In case that there are any updates for usage data on a specific month which was previously harvested, there is an option to manually harvest the usage from the vendor website and upload it into Alma (Alma should identify that the usage already exists for this specific month and will override the 'old' data)
I just tried Springer which is certified and it did not have a URL. Why would that be?	Please try again, Springer is a certified SUSHI vendor which has a URL (see image above)
Data is often "corrected" by vendors at a later date - will the updated data be loaded into Alma?	Same answer as the #8th question: Alma looks internally at the previously harvested reports and their specific month before harvesting usage data from the vendor, Alma will not attempt to harvest any report which was previously harvested.
