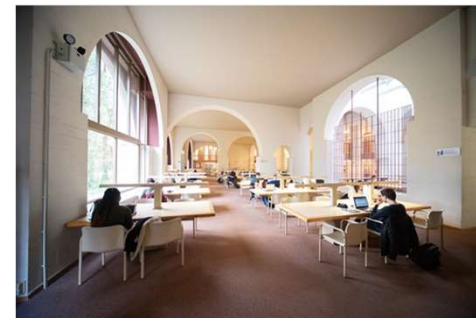
- Established in 1817
