# Key pillars of the Leganto new user experience

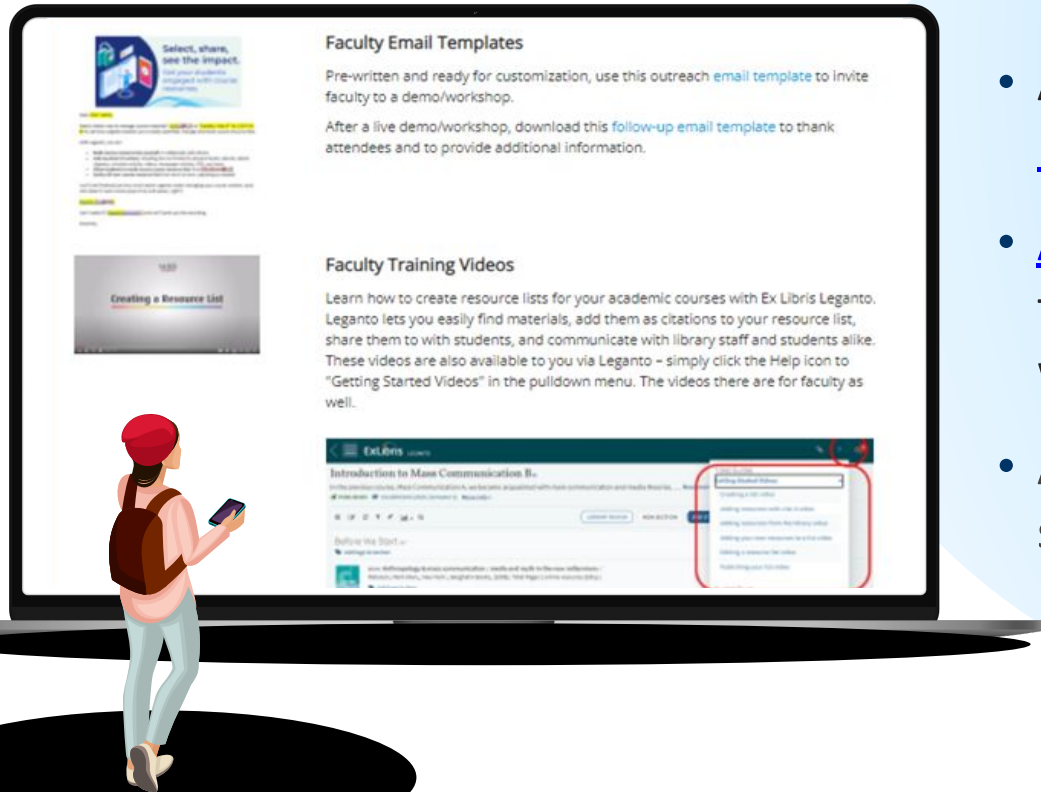

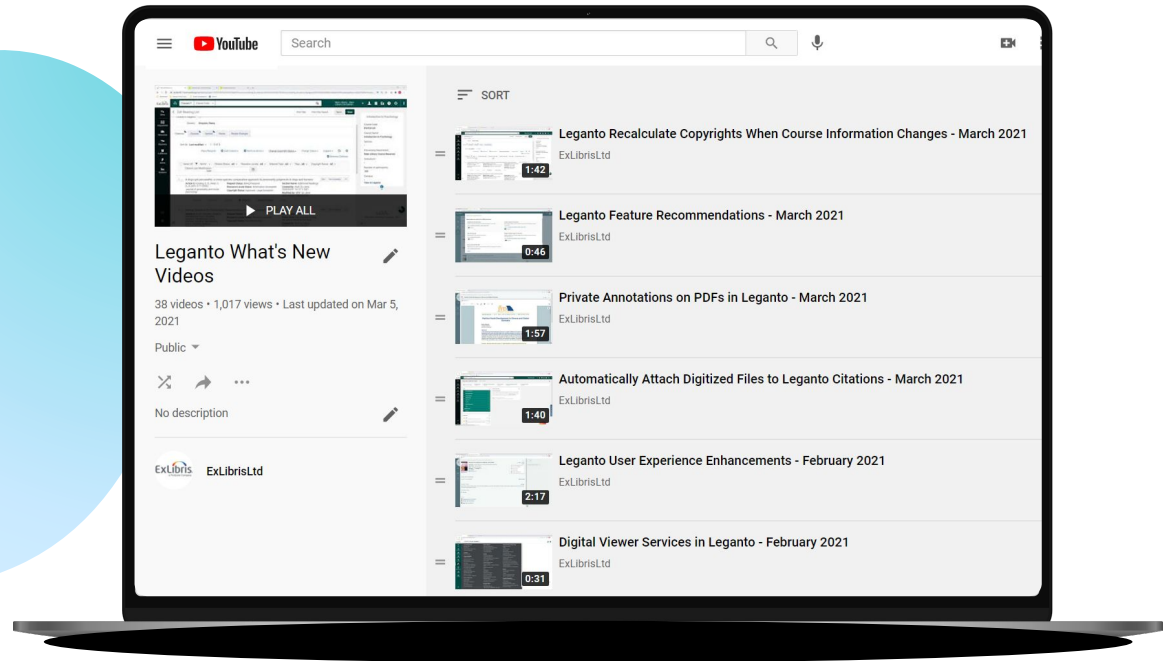

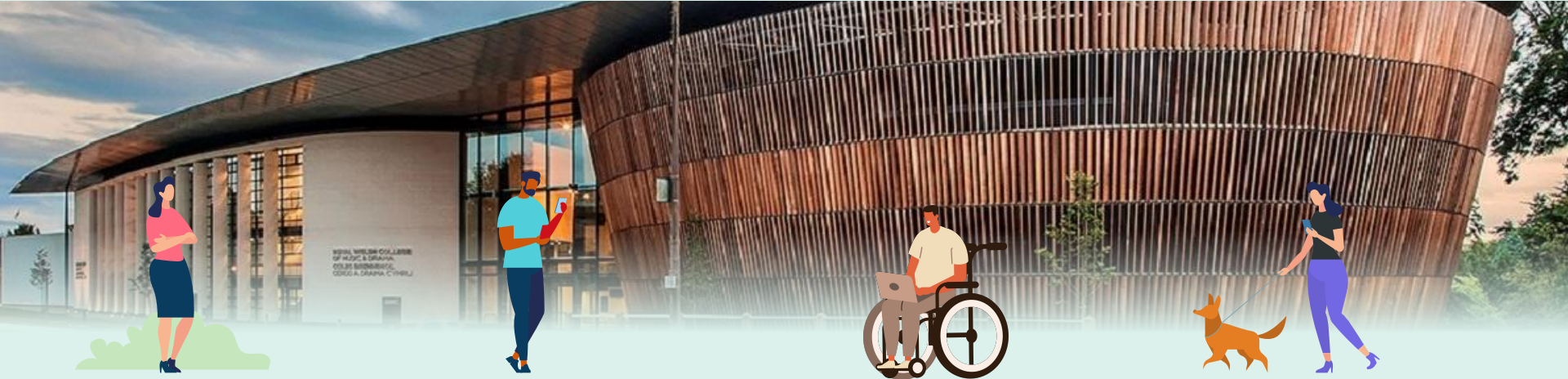
