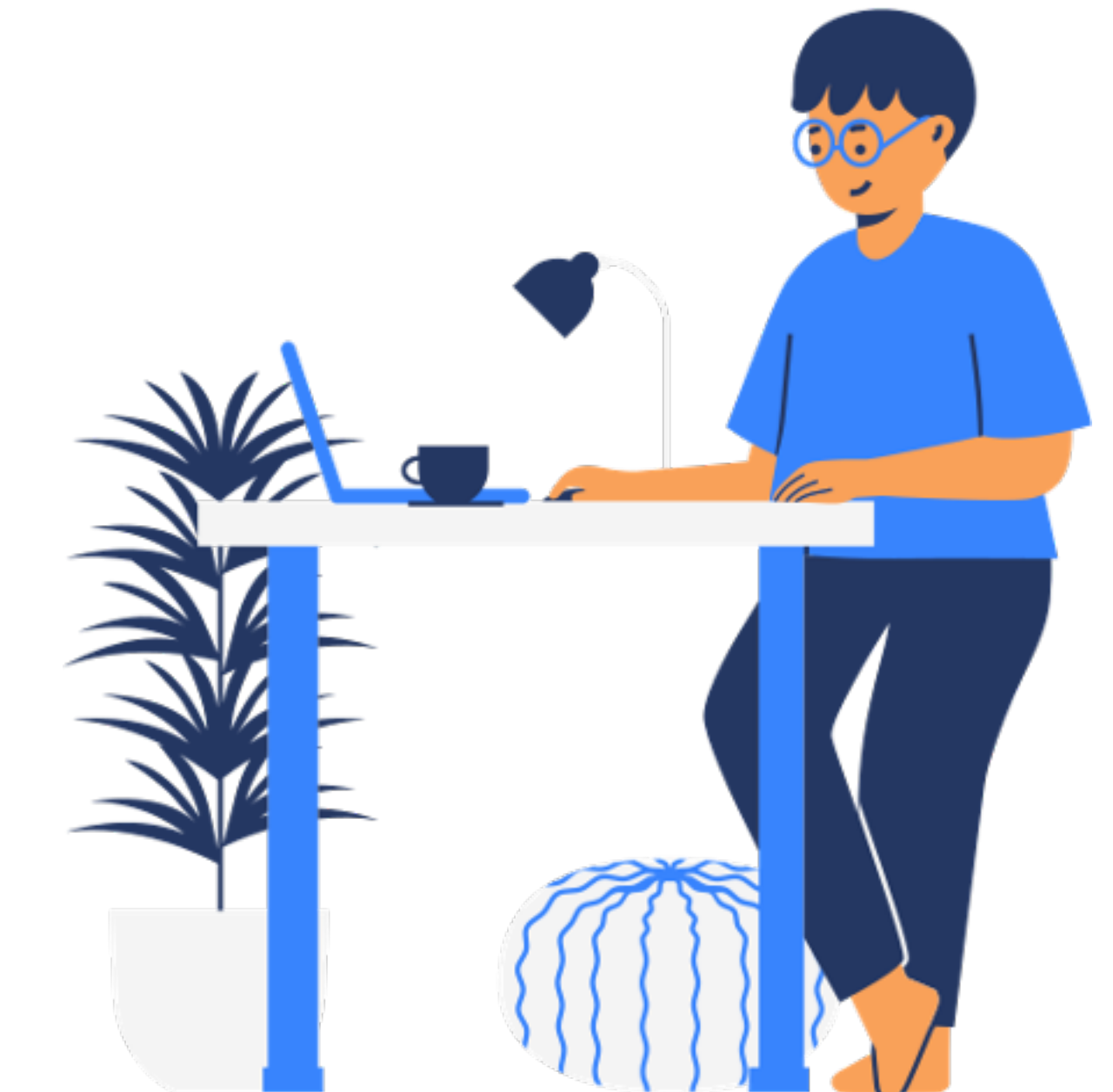

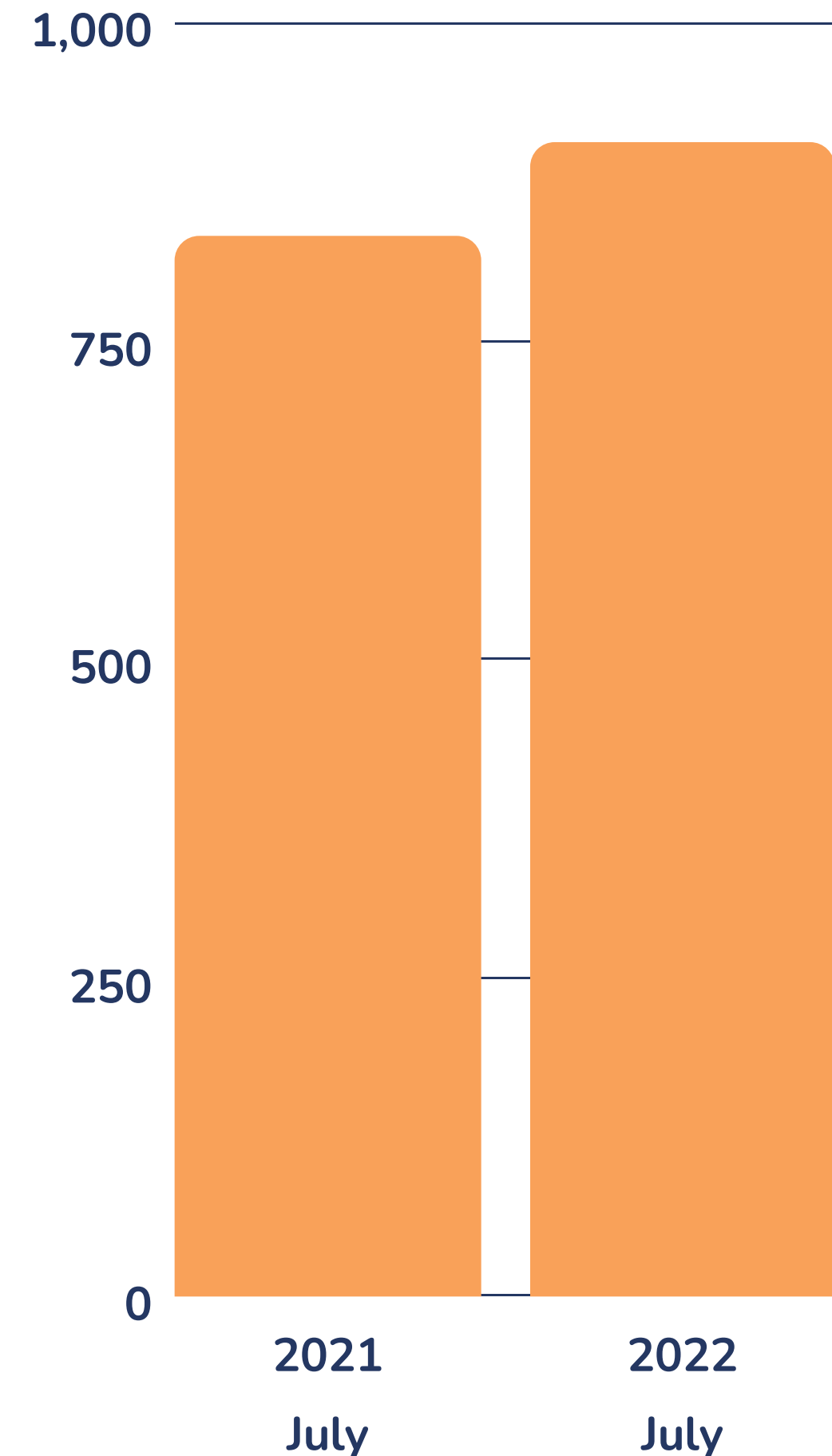

Subscriptions increased to 906 this year, including new subscriptions from Japan, Mexico, Switzerland and Taiwan.

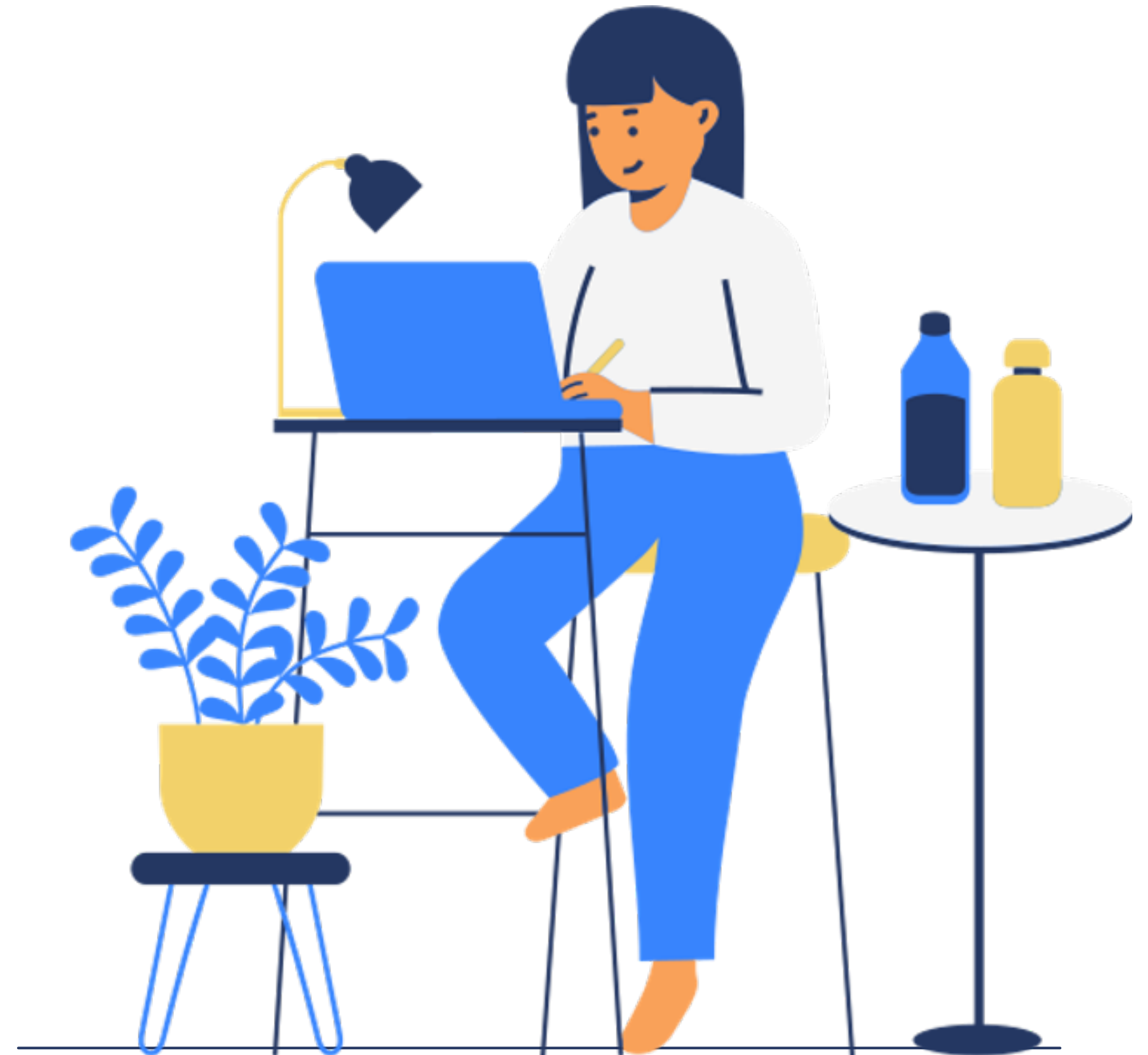
