History & Structure

Joint IGeLU/ELUNA Working Group since 2017

- had been a separate user group since 2010 but not part of IGeLU/ELUNA

Sub-working groups focused on specific areas

- Delivery & Integrations
- Digital Preservation (officially combined with Format Library WG this year)
- System Operations

Enhancement Process

- Not the same as other WG. Do not use NERS.
- This is because DP needs to be considered as the highest priority -some functionality if implemented as requested by a single customer might compromise that.
- Enhancements can be added to the Ideas Exchange (where there is no commitment to doing them).
- Sub-working Group leads collect enhancements related to their work areas from WG members and the larger user community and choose which ones to develop into full requirements documents.
- Those documents from each WG are sent up to SC and then to EL for comment and further discussion twice a year (in April and October).
- They have no obligation to complete any of the work, but have a track record of making improvements to the system based on our requests.
- **Submitted 8 requests in 2020 of which 7 have been added to the product (more forthcoming).**

Delivery & Integrations WG

Last year:

- Coordinated testing and feedback for the MVP of Structural IEs.
- Held information sessions on topics such as web archiving and OAI harvesting.
- Used feedback from these information sessions to develop future enhancement requests.

This coming year:

- Coordination of testing and feedback for new Structural IE developments (CSV ingest, access rights, etc.)
- Holding an information session on the Universal Viewer and Delivery (Will use the feedback from the information session to develop future enhancement request)
- 2 enhancements related to Thumbnail Generation in process
- 1 enhancement related to OAI harvesting in process

Digital Preservation/Format Library WG

Last year:

- 4 enhancements submitted for 7.3
- 3 enhancements related to the format library in process
- 3 FL releases: 7.1099 in January 2022 , 7.1100 in March 2022, and 7.2104 in July (DROID updated to v6.5.2, updated JHOVE modules)
- FL Maintenance: Added new property to Mediainfo Mapping and Continued working on adding more extractors through global release

This coming year:

- Current enhancement requests including assigning multiple classifications to metadata extractor & assigning multiple classifications to a file format
- Testing and further enhancing separation of metadata extraction & validation
- Updating community-maintained format library with new properties to be extracted and new mappings

System Operations WG

Last year:

- Rosetta 7.3: *Adding and Editing FileOriginal Path through the UI and Read-only user role*
- Rosetta 7.4: *Generate Logical StructMap from existing Logical StructMap and Enhancing date field search*
- Continued work on several more enhancement request to submit in 2022 including *Set privileges-group on IE export and Rosetta version API*

This coming year:

- Submitting 2 enhancements for Oct deadline: *Enhance itemized set functionality and Validate sourceMD on ingest/AIP update*
- Working through more enhancements

- July: Data model and configuration documentation
- September: Pre-ingest/ingest workflows
- November: Content (e.g. A/V, metadata for different kind of content)
- Jan: Format library, working in TAW (with Jan giving a Format Library 101 presentation)
- Mar: Storage, backups and ongoing maintenance

Revision of Terms of Reference

- Approved at annual meeting

Significant changes:

- reframed the Deputy Coordinator position as the Incoming Coordinator and defined that role in more detail
- officially merged the Digital Preservation and Format Library sub-working groups under the name “Digital Preservation Working Group”
- added the position of Format Library Manager to the Steering Committee
- added a code of conduct (IGeLU's) and a sunset clause

WG meeting this Year

- June 2-4, 2022 online
- Scheduled sessions over 3 days across time zones with a focused 2-hour time slot when it wasn't too late or too early for most to have more general sessions. Then some sessions for each region.
- This year added a Hack-a-thon that ran throughout the 3 days
- Recordings, slides and notes from most of the sessions are available on the Confluence wiki
- Largest group to ever attend – 91 registrants from 37 institutions in 12 countries

Moving Forward

Open discussion sessions – roughly bimonthly

- September: Governance/advocacy– SCHEDULED FOR SEPT 29
- November: System comparison
- January: Structural IEs
- March: Addressing Technical Analyst issues
- May: SOWG Topic TBD

Large pieces of work for the coming year:

- Continuing Validation Stack re-think
- Continuing design and implementation of structural IEs
- Development of a code of conduct
