 - Decreased turnaround from 48-72 hours to below 35 hours

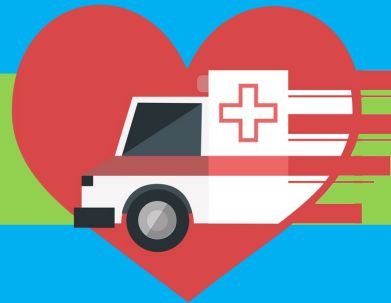

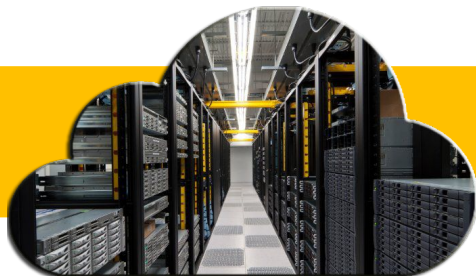
