Three extra columns, Field location in Alma, Data Type and Data Size, have been added to this table, compared to other tables in the Funds Expenditure page (https://knowledge.exlibrisgroup.com/Alma/Product Documentation/010Alma Online Help (English)/080Analytics/AlmaAnalytics Subject Areas/Funds Expenditure).  The Analytics group reviewed all the rows in the PO line table and made recommendations to Ex Libris.  The Analytics group suggests to Ex Libris that a wiki should be created for all tables so that the whole user community, not just the Analytics group, could review information in the tables.
