## **ABES: The french cataloguing agency**

ABES provides higher education and research institutions with:

- A range of tools and services dedicated to the cataloguing and administration of information resources available in their libraries:
  - A shared Catalog (Sudoc)
  - Authority data and repositories (IDref)
  - A knowledge Base (Bacon)



- Legal and financial resources for pooling the resources of academic institutions:
  - Acquisition of electronic documentation (ISTEX project)
  - Framework agreement for LMS equipment (SGBM project)
- Support for the cataloguers' network (training, information sharing, general meeting)

### The SUDOC, the national catalog

Sudoc - Système Universitaire de Documentation - is the national system for shared cataloguing of documentary resources available to all university and research libraries.



Nearly 15 million bibliographic records in this catalogue describing all kinds of document




**159 institutions** (some 1,500 academic or research libraries) catalog their documents in SUDOC







# Workflow (big picture)



# **Monthly Sudoc identifiers injection**



**410,000 e-books** (we are currently testing PPN injection for serial publications) records are exported from the SUDOC every month.

They are converted from PICA to marc21 format.

Only the PPN is added to the record in field 035\$a. Exlibris does not wish to retain any other information.

**388,970 records** with PPN in the CZ

# Daily publication of portfolios to the SUDOC:



#### A logical Set:

Allows each institution to define the scope of collections to be synchronized with the SUDOC

#### A publication profile:

Publishes member portfolios in the result set each time they are created/modified/deleted.



#### Normalization rules:

In particular, they can be used to convert the campus or electronic library code into a SUDOC identifier for the library.



### An integration profile:

Defines an OAI-PMH repository that expose the portfolios



## Daily import of SUDOC record



#### **Transferring records:**

Every day, the SUDOC transfers to each institution in the network all the records **created or modified** during the day for which the institution is located.

#### Import profile:


In the event of correspondence, copy the Community zone record to the institution/network zone.






#### Normalization & merge rules :

Overwrites the CZ record with the exception of fields 035, abstracts and tables of contents.



### **Error handling**

- If there is an anomaly in the record for which you wish to create the inventory, SUDOC (CBS) blocks the creation. This occurs when:
  - the record under which the program is attempting to create an inventory does not meet the SUDOC quality criteria
  - an attempt is made to create an electronic inventory under a physical document record.
- The program generates an error message. This is transferred to the administrator with the processing report.
- All errors for the past month are accessible via API.
   This API access has enabled some establishments to report errors in Alma, creating a reminder for each record in question.



### **Outlook**

- Extend the workflow to the e-serials: an test is in process to add the PPN identifier in e-serial records of Community Zone, based on the ISSN number.
- Adapt the workflow to the physical resources: our association advocates that this project should be considered as a proof of concept and thinks that this workflow can be duplicated for other systems (and even more easily than for electronic resources, since the CZ plays no role in it). L'Abes is more prudent, in particular because it believes that its infrastructure may not be able to support such a load
- Use Sudoc metadata to enhance CZ records: nowadays, we only add the PPN identifiers to CZ records, but we could add other fields of Sudoc records and more generally replace CZ records by Sudoc records for a part or the totality of French-speaking resources. L'Abes is a cataloging agency, dedicated to providing quality records. Its records are fuller than the records of the commercial providers. This idea interests our colleague from Belgium or Switzerland and we hope that this approach (using the records of cataloging agencies rather than those of commercial providers) may interest other communities.
