





Creating an analytics object

Adding the widget to the Alma homepage



- There may be cases where the library has created a useful chart or graph in Alma analytics and certain librarians will want to add it to their Alma homepage
- This may be done by creating an Analytics object of type Widget
- After the widget is created
  - Each librarian can choose to add the widget to his or her Alma homepage depending on his or her roles.






- In this presentation we will show and example using the following Analytics report:
- Name: "Cataloger Activity"
- Directory location: /shared/Demo Alma University/Reports/Objects
  - DV and analytics/Analytics/Widgets"





•This is the report which we want to create as a widget:




Select "Analytics > My Analytics > Analytics Objects List"







• Then we will choose (on the top right) "Actions > Add New Analytics Object"







• Choose the folder and report. Optionally update the display name.




Folder and name of the report we saw a few moments ago





• In the "Report Preview" section check the box "Add as widget"








- Add the roles of the users who will be able to add this widget to their Alma homepage.
- In our case, because the report deals with cataloging, it would be relevant to add cataloging roles (and not for example fulfillment roles)
- In the "Share" section, "Roles" subsection, click "Add Roles"
- Add the desired roles





















 Alma users with at least one of the relevant roles defined in the scheduled report can add the widget top the Alma Homepage.








User 'Elly May Clampett' logs in and clicks the + sign on the top right








• The "Manage Widgets" screens opens and shows all widgets which have at least one role which the logged in user has.







• The widget is added to the Alma homepage
