

Data Excellence: Updates Challenge



Daily Ingest

- Reduce turnaround time to daily updates
- 20 million portfolios affected
- ~165,000 activations
- By end of 2023: 70% of automated CZ portfolios will be updated daily

Create automation, improve ingest process, clean up collections







Data Excellence: Quality Challenge

Better metadata through various sources

- Selecting highly activated eBook collections:
 - So far over 153K Bib records enriched
 - Planning to enrich ~200K Bib records by end of 2023
 - Over 20,500 activations







Data Excellence: Quality Challenge

- Cooperating with providers
 - Reviewing available metadata
 - Increase capacity of Provider Relations team

- Alternative sources enrichment
 - LoC print records
 - Project Gutenberg
 - Future prospect Al












Data Improvements in CDI to Enhance Discoverability and User Experience

Document Attributes (Secondary Resource Types)

Definition	 Attributes associated with a record to provide more information Does not replace but adds value to the existing 'primary' resource type
Purpose	 Display additional information about the record/item (display flag) Used in search and as filters (facets)
Priority 2023	 Review article Primary source Preprint Retracted publication Retraction notice Withdrawn publication Withdrawal notice/ item withdrawal










OA Handling for Hybrid (and other) OA Articles



Handling of hybrid Open Access articles in CDI

 DBID level collections can be activated for some publishers (where we have reliable flags on article level), including SAGE, Emerald, OUP, IEEE, Taylor & Francis, Springer (more will be added)



NEW: we are indexing Unpaywall

- Can be activated as DBID level database
- Can be used as Link in Record resource or/and in combination with the API
- Available in November





Other CDI Data Enhancements in 2023

New resource types (for Primo): magazines, magazine articles, questionnaire

<add release date and affected collections>

- Improve consistency of language and publication date fields between Index and display
- Better identification of **book reviews** by a set of rules







Subject Heading Normalization Project



Three Fields

- Subject: populated from controlled vocabulary, deduplicated and normalized
- Keyword: all subjects/keywords that cannot be mapped to the subject field
- LATER Discipline: all discipline level subjects, according to a controlled list



Iteration 1

- Subject and keyword field
- LCSH, MeSH, and some additions from PQ thesauri
- Optional: opt-in by activating it November (Summon), February (Primo)
- Test option (for the facets) available for Primo customers &searchCDI=normalizedSubjects

• Enrich CDI with **ORCIDs** and connect to author names where available, to identify authors better

Both the subject and the author project help us to move towards a Linked Data Network in CDI










Data Excellence for Rights and Access

Quicker Availability with Faster Rights Processing

From 100 hours to an average of 30 hours to process activation to discovery







Fulltext Access Enhanced: Linking Improvements

Increased use of document ID for linking accuracy

- Focus on Quicklinks
- Now with 37 supported providers
- Over 16,304 collections with 1.56 billion records
- Linking success rates 99%
- Over 400 institutions currently active or testing
- More than 1.3m clicks in March 2023
