(Aha implementation) Summary meeting 30th of April 2024

Below is a summary of the action items derived from today's AHA discussion, paired with my perspective and proposed next steps:

- 1. Ryan will post a message on Basecamp for all AHA implementers, instructing them to review his response to the submitted feedback (the spreadsheet) by May 13th.
- 2. During ELUNA, there will be a meeting for All-cords (ELUNA-side). A Zoom link will be provided by ELUNA so that members on the IGELU-side can participate remotely. ELUNA will ensure that remote participants can hear the discussion clearly.
 - <dwa 02/05/2024> Zoom links sent to Allen Jones to be added to existing calendar invites
- 3. We need to create a short-list of necessary statuses for a NERS request, ranging from New to Done. We should aim to reach a consensus on this list during the meeting on May 13th.
- 4. On May 20th, AHA will open for the submission of new enhancement requests. After this date, no new submissions should be made through NERS.
- 5. Data will be extracted from NERS after May 20th and loaded into AHA by June 1st at the latest.
 - <dwa 02/05/2024> what happens to current NERS processes and any NERS updates
- 6. Rapido will be in production from June 1st, while the rest of the products will have access to a "sandbox" copy of the workspace (the public portal will feed into the "production" workspace). Considering that the sandbox workspaces is a feasible option within AHA, and we have the capability to conceal the production workspaces within the admin interface.
- 7. The Working Group (WG) can utilize the sandbox data to familiarize themselves with the interface. At some point during the fall, we will delete the sandbox workspaces and activate the production workspaces in the admin interface.
- Each WG involved in the enhancement process will receive one login for the admin interface. For the Public
 interface, each institution will receive one login (similar to the current NERS system). Please note, this is institutional
 login, not individual login.

Consortia Community of Practice group - 2023 chair report

New members

Stine Bovbjerg Schultz, from the Royal Danish Library, joined the group. She's experienced and will probably attend the group open meeting in IGeLU.

Advocacy activities

NERS requests with consortia interest were highlighted for members to support them.

Follow-up of EXL will to improve central NZ management with a focus on the priority and the scope of the settings to be inherited from NZ to IZs, including e-resources management.

Finally an open meeting in Leuven was hold and turned into a roundtable around consortia needs.

A few weeks after IGeLU, the group coordinator had an accident and due to his medical recovery there was no meeting in Q4.

Presentations

- Bibnet.lu library network presented its Alma & Primo migration project.
- Presentation of how Austrian OBV network uses reminders for triggering processes.
- Renouvaud presented a feedback of its implementation of Rapido.
- SLSP presented its current issues with Dedup and FRBR. A call was launched to other consortia to share their
 experiences in this field.

Practices sharing

Many workarounds were presented by CSUCC. This was a basis of experience sharing, with a focus on AFN. Later on, CSUC presented its implementation of AFN and its current limitations in a consortial environment.

NERS interesting proposals for consortia were communication starters around e-resources, user management, digital representation or Primo view distribution mechanism.
