Annual Meeting with Ex Libris Management:

The Steering Committee and chairs of the Alma, Primo and ER PWGs met with Ex Libris management in April 2024 to discuss the following Israeli-specific issues:

- Al for EXL documentation EXL will implement this
- Deletion of portfolios with changed ownership EXL will try to improve warnings before deletions
- Exporting and sharing of cases submitted by other Israel institutions EXL will do this providing that each institution signs a consent agreement
- SLA for resolution of cases and not just for responses EXL has no such SLA
- Support staff sign-in without requesting credentials from the customer EXL will try to find a solution

- Improvement of UI Labels in Arabic

Key Primo Outstanding Issues

- Missing Multilingual support for NLI authorities in Primo VE
 - a. Lack of Authority Enrichment for local indexes loss of NLI multilingual capabilities
 - b. Authority metadata cannot be edited by NR
- Multilingual Basecamp Project & Israeli Team are waiting for EXL collaboration
- UX in mobile devices needs improved responsiveness, especially the Advanced Search in the Hebrew interface

Other issues

- Possible integration of Hebrew, RTL and Israeli CDI content into the upcoming AI releases
- Possible support of Language Models in NDE
- Possible full-text indexing of Israeli providers' content

Key Content Outstanding Issues

- Electronic Inventory
- AutoHoldings CZ and publisher feeds still not calibrated
- Existing CZ activations require perpetual monitoring and repairing of baseline inventory
- Maximizing the full metadata potential of universities' and National Library's collections in CZ & CDI
- Non-preferred terms (cross-references) from Authority Enrichment
- IHP Missing support for multiple full text links (in records)
- Portfolio Public Notes containing volume / Issue
