





NERS – enhancement Procedure!



(Collaboration between the Alma user community and ExLibris)

- For each enhancement request:
 - basecamp discussion with NERS submitter AND Alma (sub) group representative/Stewards!
 - verify that the understanding of the requirements are aligned
 - outline high level solution (ExLibris)
 - receiving confirmation for high level solution (Alma Community)
- List of NERS enhancements for the cycle are finalized according to priority and complexity points Start Implementation:
 - Add High level solution to <u>NERS article</u>
 - Share FSD (full scale dev.) with NERS submitter AND Alma (sub) group representative/Stewards!
 - Follow-up development via Basecamp

Ongoing Concerns!

(Continuous focus between Alma WG and ExLibris)

- Alma response times (Survey intermittent slowness)
 - > 55 institutions responded, some with multiple responses
 - ➢ AP 6
 - ➢ NA 16
 - ► EU 33
 - ➢ ⅓ submitted cases
 - Across all areas
- Quality Assurance (QA)
 - Understanding the Ex Libris-process of "bug fixing"
 - 'Consolidation'!
- Collaboration & Communication
 - Idea Exchange "ideas older than 2 years from the last comment AND which have less than 30 votes were closed"




