Introducing the unified title search experience

Based on user studies feedback: Different information and abilities per search is confusing



Handle all Alma title searches

A unified experience for All, Physical, Electronic and Digital Titles



Same available actions

Actions available (and configurable) according to record & privileges



All inventory displayed

No need to check the All-Titles search to see if the record has other inventory



Differences where needed

Functional, inventorydependent differences will remain - e.g. search indexes, search results, facets



Bibliographic metadata

The same available (and configurable) bibliographic metadata fields displayed



UX Methodology



Gather requirements from the community using extensive user studies (via UX focus group)



Prototype design & new user studies to evaluate the design and our UX assumptions




Develop solution, early testing, gather feedback prior to release. Together with extensive QA process done on our end.



General release of the solution a "feature rollout" plan (Opt in/out gradual deployment)

Find what you need: Improved search capabilities

- Group search conditions
- Determine each group's Boolean condition







Find what you need: Enhanced facets

- Multi-select facets
- Exclude a value
- Search within facets
- Save your facets for use in next searches








Browse and compare record information

- The full bibliographic record is available in the right-pane
- Easily move between records using the up/down arrow buttons, comparing bibliographic metadata, inventory information and more






Do more directly from the search results


Depending on your permissions, you'll be able to perform more actions from the search, e.g.:

- Suppress a bibliographic record
- Withdraw an item
- Activate an electronic portfolio






Linked Open Data elements and navigation

Info-cards: Contributor info at a glance

- Displays basic information on contributor
- Easy navigation to:
 - The creator's Wikidata page
 - The full contributor page showing more detailed information
 - A new titles search for this person in the library's catalog (based on linked authority record)






Linked Open Data elements and navigation

Contributor Page: Contributor info deep dive

- Displays detailed information from both External sources and the library's catalog.
- Provides links to relevant pages in external sources, such as "See More in Wikipedia".
- Review at a glance other titles related to the contributor:
 - As a contributor
 - As a subject







Linked Open Data elements and navigation


Contributors section: All the contributors' information at your fingertips:

- Name
- Info-card (if available)
- Contributor page link (if available)
- Link to authority record (if exists)
- A navigation option to a new titles search (by linked authority if exists, and the bib heading text if not)




