#### **READING LIST RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Instructors, Technology Enhanced Learning Designers and Faculty Librarians:** Creates and edits lists. Librarians suggest replacements or alternative resources.

**Customer Services team:** Digitises readings and moves physical items to high demand locations.

**Information Resources team:** Purchases resources and new editions.

**Service:** Provision of all Library materials for teaching managed via Leganto. Resource List Framework outlines service. No limit on number of citations.

**Instructors:** Option to build/edit own lists or send to the Library via online form.

**Library Learning Services team:** builds/edits/reviews lists, submits purchase/scan requests, deals with support queries, creates guidance materials, advocacy & engagement. Moves Essential print books to 3 hour loan.

Works with **E-reserve team** (Digitises readings) & **Acquisitions team** 

**Informations Systems team:** provide Alma technical support and analytics reporting.

**Instructors:** option to build/edit own lists or book an appointment with the Library for help creating a list. Uploads digital scans (*subject to change in 2025*). Publishes list (which "sends to Library" at the same time).

**Access Services team:** reviews & manages lists, purchases new resources (through Purchase Requests using Rialto), manages instructor-uploaded files in Alma-D, handles support queries, maintains front-facing guidance materials.

**Online Services team:** provides Alma technical support and analytics reporting, maintains internal staff training material.

**Liaison librarians:** promotes reading list service to instructors and passes on queries.

APIs: create course and reading list (1:1), add the citation containing the link the syllabus, add the reading list owner.  Faculty Librarians: edit list, add required readings, suggest replacements (copyright compliance), provide support, promote the adding in Moodle of the link to Leganto.  Instructors: add citations (link to Primo records or file upload for which they declare the copyright compliance), add in Moodle the link to Leganto.

#### **OUR CHALLENGE**

Leganto were implemented in 2016 as replacement of an in-house developed tool, that was the only available for sharing teaching material (1 million events/year). With the pandemic (= Moodle/Teams adoption), usage is drastically decreased. How to convince instructors and students of the value of the integrated solution?
