Enhancement rejection policy (draft 1)

Entering and voting for enhancement to products covered by the Collaborative Software Agreement between Clarivate and the user organizations ELUNA and IGeLU, are privileges held by member institutions of one of the user organizations.

When you enter enhancement proposals for this process, you do so as a representative of your institution, whose membership we value. Please note the following requirements:

1. Enhancements must be made using an email address belonging to your institution email domain. We reserve the right to delete enhancement proposals without further notice, if the affiliated email address is not from a member institution domain.
2. The team of volunteers preparing the ballot may need to contact the submitter to rephrase or gain a better understanding of the proposal. If the submitter does not respond to repeated contacts on the affiliated email address, we reserve the right to delete the proposal, or rephrase it as we see fit, without further notice.

Key takeaways (TL;DR)

- AHA replaces NERS as the portal for submitting enhancement requests
- AHA is in production and you should not use NERS any longer
- Submission is open for all and you can create an account from the login page
- Voting on enhancements will be performed in a separate system: ElectionBuddy
- It's not possible to see current voting results and you can only vote once
- Invitations to vote are based on the products licensed by your institution. The membership database must be kept up to date with the current subscriptions

The Aha Enhancements Portal is the new system replacing NERS. Aha will be used for the collection of community-submitted product enhancements to be voted upon by IGeLU and ELUNA members.

We are pleased to advise that the Aha Enhancements Portal is officially in production.

Legacy data has been extracted from NERS and loaded it into Aha. Initial enhancements cycles have been run successfully by two Product Working Groups (Esploro and Rapido/RapidILL).

The data extraction from NERS was completed in May. The responsible Product Working Group will ensure that any requests submitted to NERS after that time will be added in to the Aha Enhancements Portal, before NERS is decommissioned.

Effective today, please submit all new enhancements requests to the Aha Enhancements Portal: <https://enhancements.exlibrisusers.org/>.

There is a sign up link on the login page. When creating an account you are encouraged to use your professional email address from your institution, rather than a personal email.

Steps for submitting an enhancement are available in the following guide: [LINK to PDF somewhere (IGELU website?)

We recommend including as much information as possible in your request. Focus on the problem that needs to be solved (the desired outcome), rather than proposing specific solutions (there might be multiple ways to address an issue/request). The working groups have the mandate to reject or delete submissions that do not meet certain quality standards.

Voting on enhancements will be performed in a separate system: ElectionBuddy. ElectionBuddy streamlines the voting process by sending a targeted email to IGeLU and ELUNA institutions eligible to vote in a ballot, containing a secure link to vote.

It is crucial that the institutional profile information in the ELUNA or IGeLU membership system is kept up to date for both the products licensed and the current email for a voting representative staff member or body.

ElectionBuddy also brings a range of in-built conditions ensuring integrity of voting processes, including preventing visibility of current voting results and allowing a single vote submission with no subsequent changes.

We extend thanks to the Steering Committee liaisons and Product Working Group representatives for their work on the Aha Implementation Project thus far, and look forward to an improved enhancements cycle experience using the Aha Enhancements Portal and ElectionBuddy.
