Data Extraction

- Extract from Cinema museum catalogue in JSON format
- No OAI-PMH industry standard for harvesting stands for Open Archives Initiative Protocol for Metadata Harvesting
- Created mapping tables for key fields
 - Resource Type
 - Language
- Converted from JSON to XML issues with the data, conversion and arrays



 - There are over 500 Archive Collections and the example is to the right.
- The Second is to add the Archive Collection name to the items within each Collection example to the right:
