Background Information	Ex Libris customers need to use products that do not disadvantage users with disabilities. Many web accessibility problems have been discovered and reported by customers, with varying levels of attention and correction from Ex Libris. Likewise, members have used the products in innovative ways to improve experiences for users with disabilities that could be shared more effectively across the community. To advance accessibility, the customer-base can collaborate on directions and speak with a unified voice to more effectively influence Ex Libris' commitment to accessible solutions. Accessibility transcends individual products and content. Individual product working groups would benefit from the support of a community of practice to deal with the intricacies of the legal and civil requirements for accessibility that impact many of our libraries.
Terms of Reference	Accessibility Community of Practice members meet on a quarterly basis to discuss and create action items related to accessibility features, bugs, defects, and difficulties across Ex Libris products. Provide and gather feedback on accessibility problems discovered by Ex Libris customers and library patrons in direct meetings and related communications with Ex Libris. The Community of Practice can support and amplify the voices of those identifying and reporting accessibility bugs and issues. Provide and gather feedback on ways to improve and advocate for functional accessibility usability over technical accessibility(i.e WCAG, in the narrow sense) in direct meetings and related communications with Ex Libris. The user experience must be important beyond technical usability. In accord with the resolution agreement between the University of Montana and US Department of Education, Office of Civil Rights, "'Accessible' means that individuals with disabilities are able to independently acquire the same information, engage in the same interactions, and enjoy the same services within the same timeframe as individuals without disabilities, with substantially equivalent ease of use." Equity and utility should be put forward as a priority, not solely compliance.
