#### **Professional Background**

With over 20 years in the library field, I have worked across a wide range of institutions—from small cultural organizations to major academic libraries. A key part of my professional journey includes six years as a project manager in customer services for library software companies (GEAC Computers France and ALS France), which gave me practical experience of the vendor-side perspective on software operations, business motivations, and customer services.

This background positioned me to manage our migration to Alma/Primo in 2020, after which I took on the role of Alma administrator. Alongside this, I remain actively involved in day-to-day library operations as a reference librarian for German-language materials in the social sciences.

My international experience continues with my current role leading a working group within our University's European Alliance, CIVICA. I collaborate with colleagues from ten European partner institutions to develop shared library services that support joint education and research initiatives.
