History of RapidILL: From Crisis...

- 1997: Spring Creek flood destroys Colorado State University's Morgan Library serials collection
- 1997-2001: Emergency service established with 4 peer libraries for next-day article delivery
- 2001: Expanded to two-way "Rapid" borrowing system
- 2001+: CSU invests \$750K to enhance software for broader participation



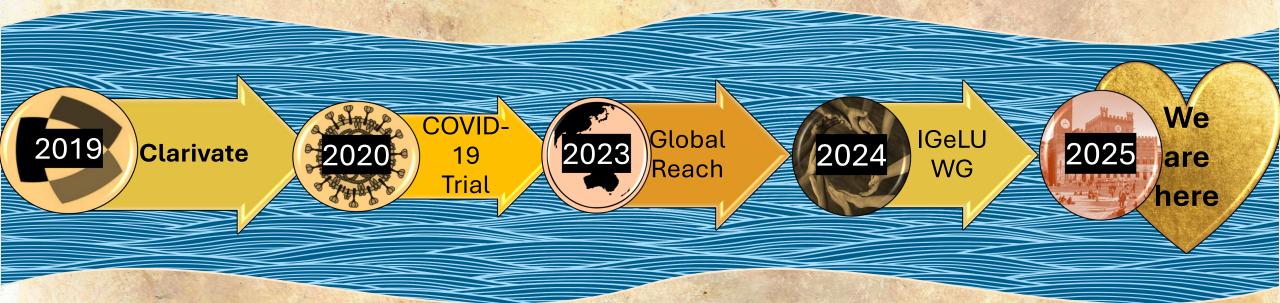
- 2005: Service launch
- 2013: Book chapters added
- 2014: Returnable items pilot
- 2018: Bedrock development

With each connection made, our RapidILL community grows stronger.

2025

- 850+ institutions
- 36 countries
- Average TAT is now only 9.5 hours
- 25 million+ RapidILL requests total!



- 2019: Clarivate acquisition
- 2020: COVID-19 free borrowing offer

- 2023: Rapid global expansion
- 2024: IGeLU RapidILL working group formed



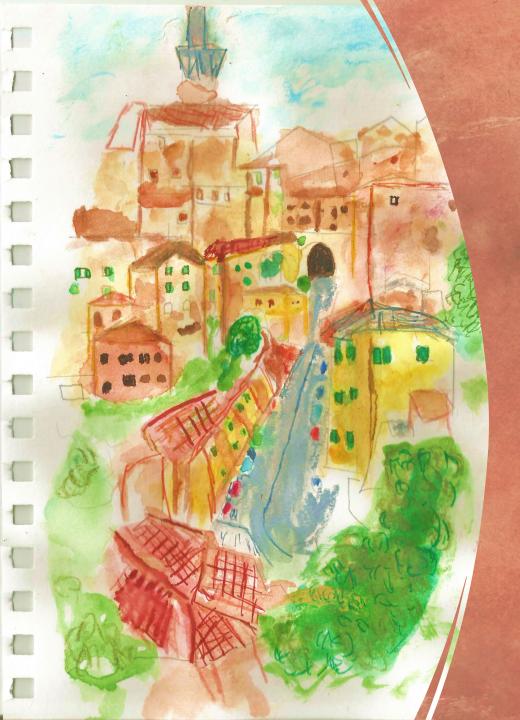

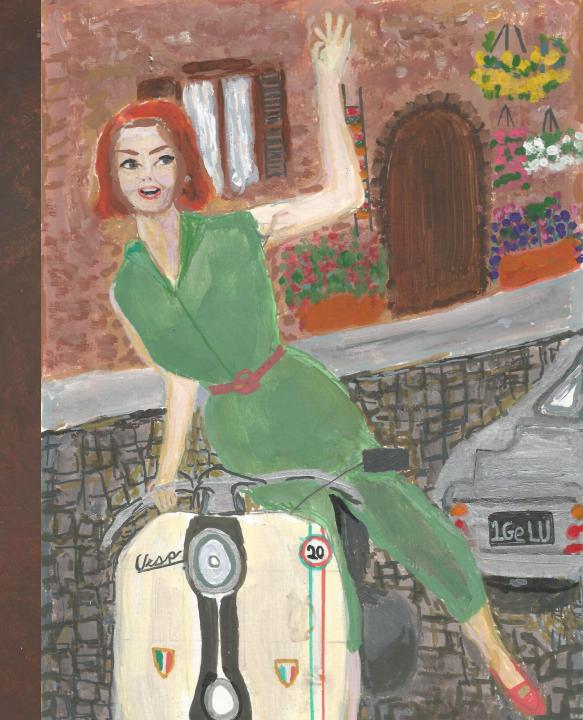

- Collaborative effort: Both RapidILL and Rapido Working Groups across IGeLU and ELUNA.
- 61 votable suggestions filtered.
- Contributed to community communications, documentation and discussions around timeline and voting rounds.

Our ideas in the CERV 2025 vote



- In total, working group members contributed 6 of the votable ideas, which attracted a combined 2574 votes (10.78% of all votes cast).
- Ideas were generated by listening to the community and from our resource sharing practitioner work.
- After round one voting and initial pointing by Clarivate, 2 ideas made it through to round two voting. These ideas were generated by Lynne and Karen.

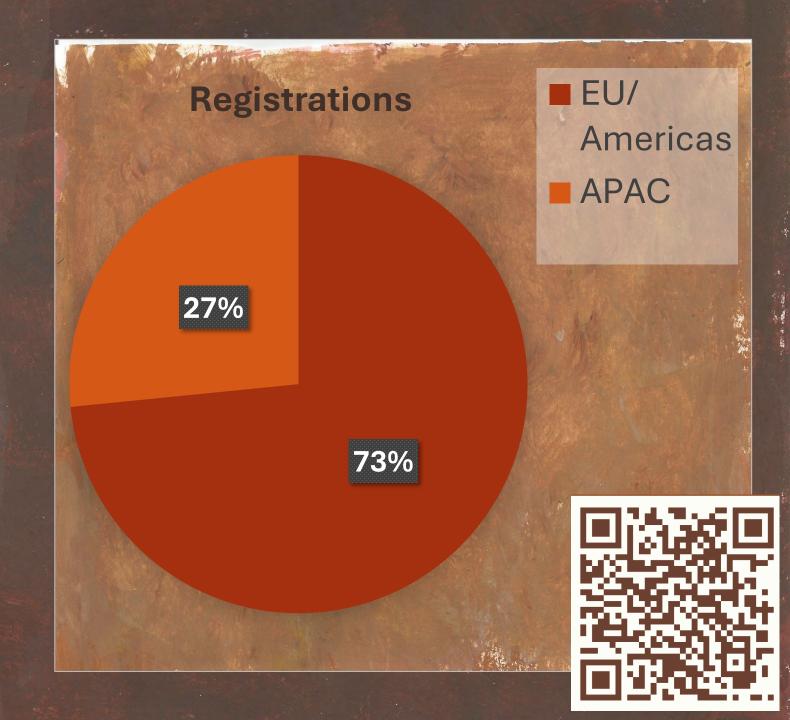

- Real impact: Reports delivered in July 2025 Alma release

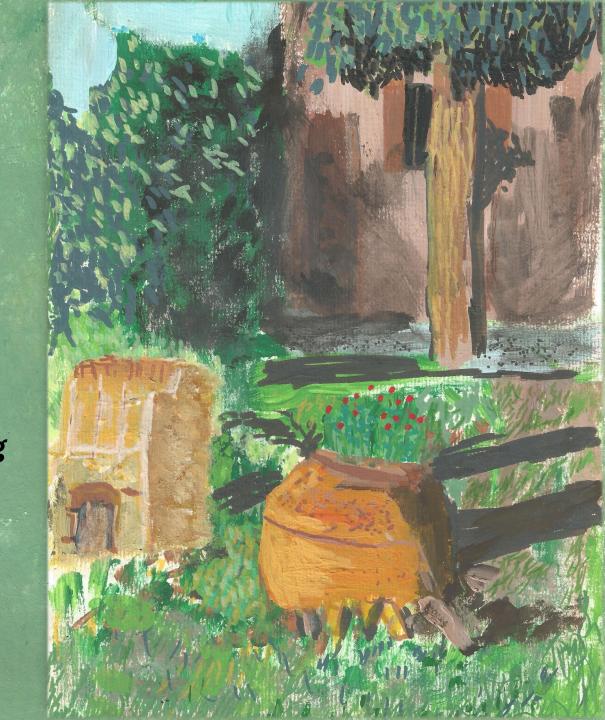


Recognition: Celebrating Lynne's outstanding community contribution

- Widening participation from underrepresented regions

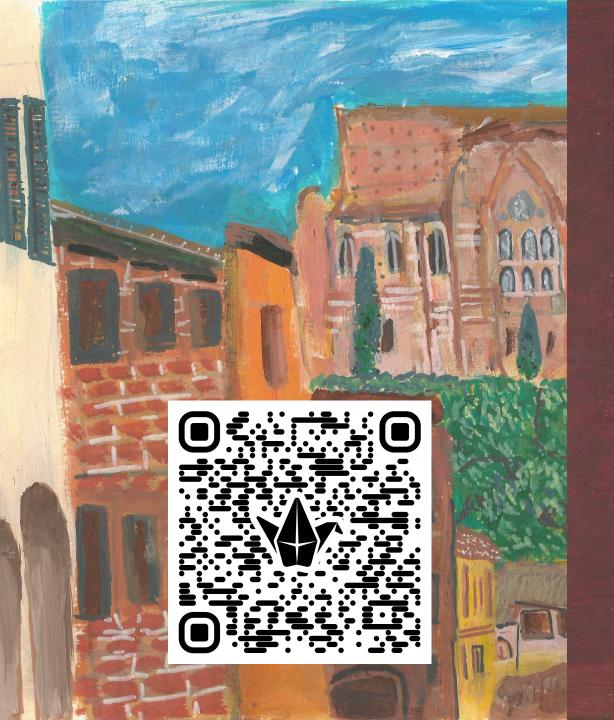
Expanding Community Knowledge
