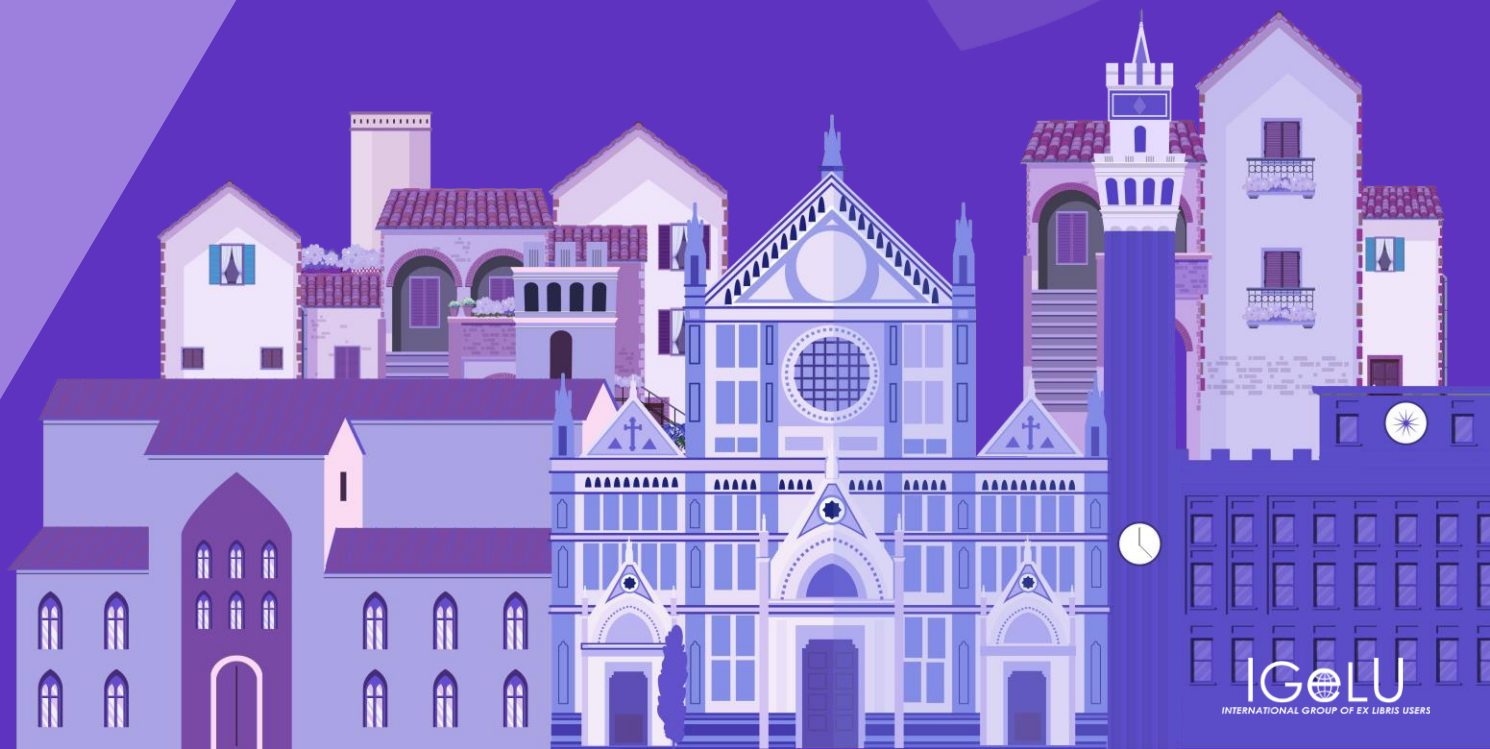

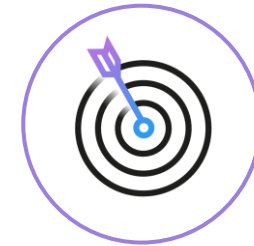

Ukraine Initiative Update

Launched March 2022

- Ukraine libraries are setup with full borrowing access to RapidILL
- All pods plus Internet Archive

49 Ukraine libraries are registered to borrow from the community

4,300 article and chapter requests have been fulfilled through the initiative to date



The Ukrainian Catholic University Library received access to the RapidILL system in August 2022. We were pleasantly surprised by how fast and smoothly the system works. Our students and faculty received scans of articles and book chapters from a wide variety of libraries around the world from North America, Western Europe, and even the Near East. This is an incredible opportunity for us to go beyond the limitations of our library's paper collection and provide access to the latest publications to our academic community. We would like to thank all those involved in its operation. We appreciate your support in these difficult times for Ukraine."

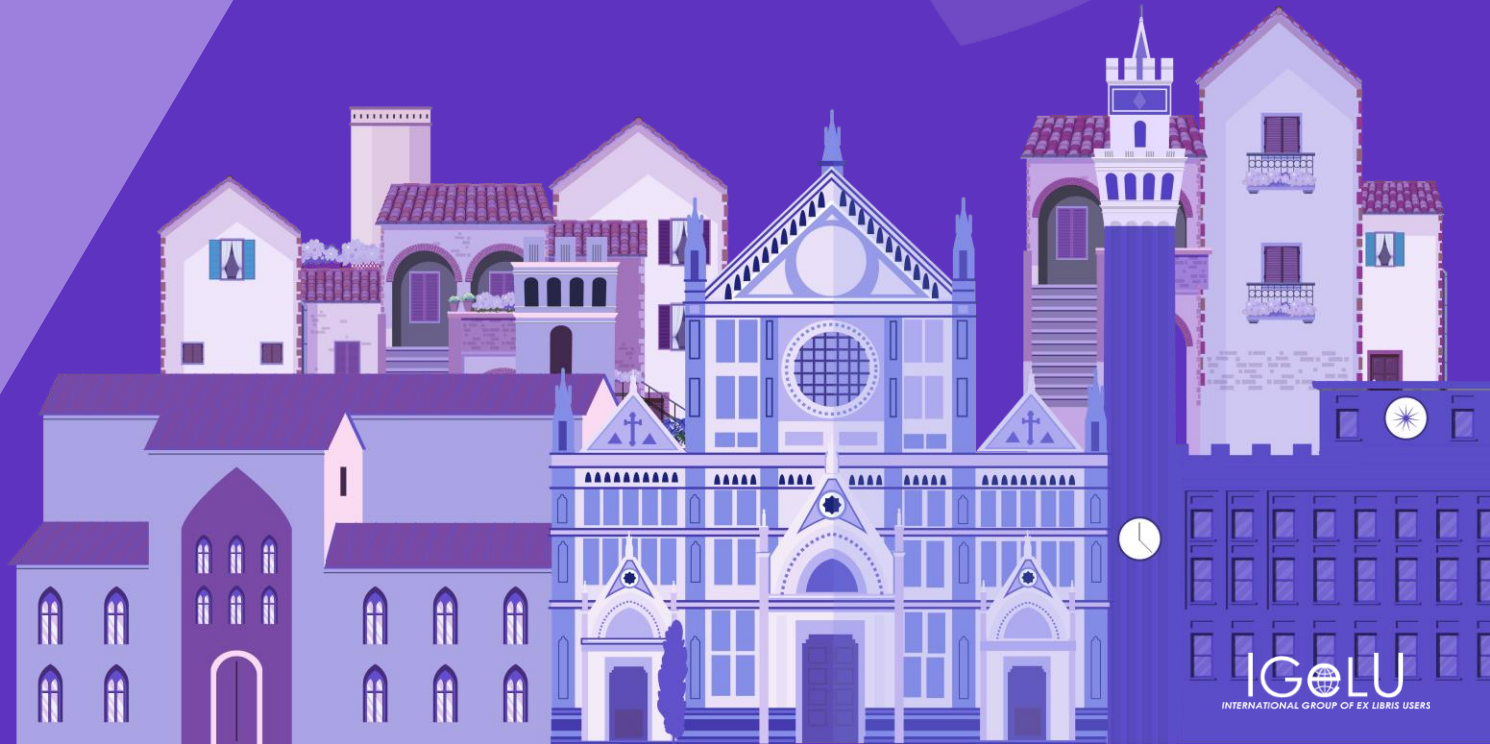

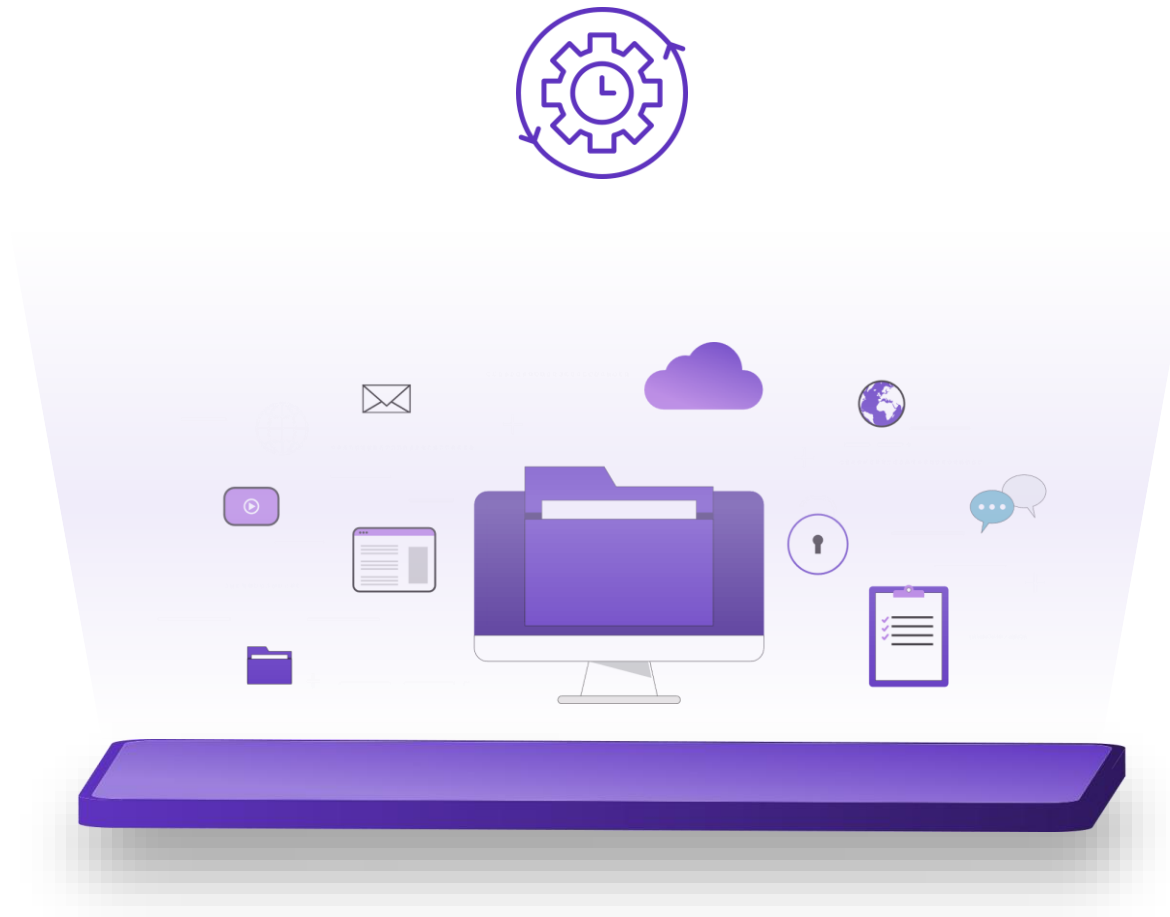

Automated Resends

- RapidILL will now automatically alert the lender if they have not provided a file for a request updated to Filled
- Minimizes the need for borrowers to monitor for this scenario
- Reduces request turnaround time

Defining Work Week permanently

It should be possible to define our work week permanently, and not via Lending Off every week. For example, our work week is Sundays-Thursdays 8:00-17:00 (not Monday-Fridays). Also, it should be possible to define Lending Off via Alma, and not just via the Rapid interface.

AI Investigations: Brainstorming and Fast POCs!



Coverage Statements

- **Goal: Improve current processes to match requests to holdings**
- Use AI to normalize coverage statements, account for variety of languages
- Improve the accuracy when sending requests to potential lenders, in turn improving fill rates and turnaround times



PDF: Quality Assurance

- **Goal: Check lender-provided PDF files for errors**
- AI will check the request metadata against the PDF of an article
- Alert lender that file is potentially problematic
- Enhance turnaround time and staff efficiency



Open Access Verification

- **Goal: Ensure that open access is supplying the correct content**
- AI will check to ensure that the content is a suitable version
- AI can identify if the actual article is behind a url on the page accessed

Coverage Statement Proof of Concept Final Results

Plan to revisit later to see if updated AI can provide better results

- Current logic is solid based on this testing
- We found areas where the current logic can be improved!
- AI ran into issues:
 - Parsing some years and volumes
 - Hallucinating years and volumes
 - Different results from the same prompt
- Costs to develop and maintain

- Lending-only member participating as part of the Boston Library Consortium
- Collections include print journals, microform and monographs
- Fill article and book chapters for no charge through RapidILL

Recent Numbers:

- Processed 88,086 requests in 2024
- 91% fill rate
- Average turnaround time less than one hour
- April 2024 processed 9,519 requests
- Currently 455 libraries setup with access
