
# Engagement with Ex Libris Esploro Product Management

## Goals:

- Address community concerns
- Advocate for product improvements
- Review Roadmap developments
- Collaborate on the enhancements process

## This year we talked about:

- The 2024/2025 enhancements, and how they were progressing
- Provided feedback about new functionality
- Progress on issues with PrimoVE integration with Esploro
- Problems with Unpaywall integration with Esploro
- Discuss the Cloud App session with an Ex Libris developer
- Discuss the release schedule for Esploro, and the impending change to quarterly from monthly, to bring in line with Alma and Primo

# Engagement with the Esploro community

## Three community discussions

**Esploro to Primo VE Integration** - Topics included publishing limitations, inventory linking issues, and OpenURL availability messaging.

**Datasets in Esploro** - Covered restricted access, file versioning, large file handling, indexing, and integration with RDMPs.

**SDGs in Esploro** – Topics included recording SDGs in Esploro, integrations with other systems, workflows and processes.

## Moderation of eList

As of July 2025, have 221 members on the Esploro eList, from 130 different institutions

# Enhancements process

## 2024 nERS cycle

5 enhancements made it through the vote and were marked as **CERV** in the release notes.  
All have been delivered in 2025.

Ability to export search results from Research Portal	232 (11.05%)	5	March 2025
Make collections searchable	194 (9.24%)	8	January 2025
Ability to shift a researcher from creator to contributor	147 (7.00%)	5	February 2025
Duplicate an existing record for a new record edit	101 (4.81%)	8	February 2025

# Enhancements process

## 2025 CERV cycle

33 enhancement requests submitted in Aha!, with the top 20 sent to Ex Libris for pointing. The top four have been selected and sent to Ex Libris for development.


# Additional activities in the last 12 months



- Updated and expanded Esploro content on the IGeLU website
- ELUNA proposed a cross-institutional dashboard to showcase community deposit metrics; a prototype has been developed and may be revisited in 2025/2026
- Esploro will adopt a quarterly release cycle from mid-2025, aligning with Alma and Primo
- IGeLU and ELUNA collaborated on an issue statement regarding Esploro's positioning within Clarivate.

- Continue bi-monthly meetings with Ex Libris Product Management
- Finalize the 2024 CERV enhancement cycle
