Gongguan Night Market (公館夜市)	Gongguan Night Market, located near National Taiwan University, is famous for its affordable street food, drinks, and lively student-friendly vibe.	Link

Explore Taipei City: Taipei 101 Area

On Free Tour D and F, you will have the chance to visit the centerpiece of the city's skyline: Taipei 101. Located in the heart of the Xinyi District, this former world's tallest building remains Taiwan's most iconic landmark. The tower features record-breaking high-speed elevators, a massive wind damper for stability, and an 89th-floor observatory offering breathtaking 360-degree views. A luxury shopping mall is also located at its base. Nearby attractions include:

Taipei 101 Observatory (臺北 101 觀景台)	Taipei 101 is the tallest building in Taiwan and the 11th tallest in the world, offering 360-degree city views from 89 th -floor observation deck. 1-minute walk from MRT Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station.	Link
Xinyi Shopping District (信義商圈)	Upscale shopping malls, department stores, restaurants, cinemas, and more. This area is in between MRT Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station and MRT	Link

44 South Military Village (四四南村)	A former military village turned cultural park, this area features cafes, local crafts, and a community center with iconic views of the nearby Taipei 101. 5-minute walk from MRT Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station.	Link
Din Tai Fung 101 (鼎泰豐 101 店)	World-renowned xiao long bao (soup dumplings). Note that queues can be long, so taking a number early is recommended.	Link
Elephant Mountain trailhead (象山步道口)	Feel energetic? Hike the Elephant Mountain trail (Xiangshan). It is a steep 30-minute climb up stairs but offers the most iconic panoramic views of the Taipei skyline. 20-minute walk from MRT Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station.	Link
National Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Memorial Hall (國立國父紀念館)	The main hall is temporarily closed for renovation until late 2026, but the outdoor park remains open, featuring a scenic lake with the best reflection views of Taipei 101. 20-minute walk from MRT Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station, or 5-minute walk from MRT Sun Yat-Sen Memorial Hall Station.	Link
Songshan Cultural and Creative Park (松山文創園區)	Previously a tobacco factory, now housing design exhibitions, a lily pond, and a large Eslite bookstore. 25-minute walk from MRT Taipei 101/World Trade Center Station, or 10-minute walk from MRT Sun Yat-Sen Memorial Hall Station.	Link
National Railway Museum (國家鐵道博物館)	This "living railway museum" in Xinyi is a former train repair hub. It features original workshops, historic locomotives, and working tracks to show Taiwan's rich	Link

National Central Library (國家圖書館)	National library of Taiwan. Located in front of “Liberty Square” of CKS Memorial Hall. Opening Hours: Tue. - Sat. 9:00-21:00; Sun.9:00-17:00. 10-minute walk from MRT NTU Hospital Station.	Link
National Taiwan Museum (國立臺灣博物館)	Located in 228 Peace Park, National Taiwan Museum houses a variety of exhibits, including history & natural history. Opening hours: 9:30 - 17:00, Tue.-Sun. 5-minute walk from MRT NTU Hospital Station.	Link
Presidential Office Building (總統府)	National monument of Taiwan. While striking by day, the building's nighttime lights create a unique, elegant vibe. Open house: weekday 9:00-12:00. Designated holiday tour in October: October 17 th (Sat.) 9:00-16:00. 10-minute walk from MRT NTU Hospital Station.	Link
Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall (中正紀念堂)	Historic monument honoring Chiang Kai-shek, featuring museum exhibits within a scenic park with traditional gardens. The outdoor honor guard drill on Democracy Boulevard is a must-see (9:00-17:00, hourly). Illumination at night is also a	Link

Huashan 1914 Creative Park (華山 1914 文化創意產業 園區)	A vibrant cultural hub set within a historic sake winery. This heritage site features unique shops, restaurants, bars, and local art. Its illuminated industrial architecture offers a perfect backdrop for a late-night stroll. It is a 30-minute walk from MRT NTU Hospital Station or 5 minutes from MRT Zhongxiao Xinsheng Station.	Link
