Software enhancements

- Ex Libris evaluated the top thirty rated enhancement requests for SFX Software Enhancements 2013 Cycle and nine were accepted for development.
- The initial Ex Libris plan was to start delivering the enhancements in SP 4.7 (scheduled for September 2014), but started earlier, already in SP 4.6.1 (released June 2014).
- According to Ex Libris, improvements not implemented in SP 4.7 will come in subsequent release.

Software Enhancements accepted for Development

- (D1) KBMANAGER: ON LIST OF PORTFOLIOS, HIGHLIGHT ACTIVE TARGETS (ERS #2210+#3122) Released on SP 4.6.1
- (D2) LIST OF PORTFOLIOS: INDICATE IF THE OBJECT PORTFOLIO HAS AS LOCAL ATTRIBUTE: THRESHOLD/PARSER (ER #2724) Released on SP 4.6.1 (Jun/09/2014)
- (D3) EXPORT TOOL: ADDITION OF COLUMN LOCAL_THRESHOLD IN THE REPORTS (ER #2196) Enhancement waiting to be implemented.
- (D4) INTEROPERABILITY: OPTION TO HIDE SFX MENU BANNER IN PRIMO CENTRAL (+ PRIMO?) IFRAME (ER #2538) Enhancement waiting to be implemented.
- (D5) KBMANAGER: CREATE MORE CONTRAST BETWEEN TABLE ROWS FOR SFX VERSION 4 (ER #2147) Enhancement waiting to be implemented.

Software Enhancements accepted for Development

- (D6) KB MANAGER: IMPROVE THE DISPLAY OF THRESHOLDS ON THE PORTFOLIO LIST FOR A TARGET (ER #3100)
Enhancement waiting to be implemented.
- (D7) OBJECTPORTFOLIO LISTS: SHOW IF A THRESHOLD IS LOCAL OR GLOBAL BY GIVING IT A DIFFERENT COLOUR (ER #3113) Enhancement waiting to be implemented.
- (D8) MENU CONFIGURATION: MAKE DISPLAY LOGIC RULES RESISTANT TO TARGET RENAMINGS (ER #2163)
Enhancement waiting to be implemented.
- (D9) KB TOOLS: KBART EXPORT FORMAT FOR INDIVIDUAL TARGETS AND/OR ALL ACTIVE TARGETS (ER #3083) Under implementation, to be released soon.
- SP 4.6.1 includes ability to use KBART format as an option for DATALOADER only (not for export yet).

Software Enhancements not accepted

- Three enhancement requests were rejected (R) by Ex Libris. These enhancement requests will not be implemented in the foreseeable future:
 - (R1) eBook Search: Add option to find eBooks by Category/Subcategory (ER #2729)
 - (R2) SFX Object Lookup/SFX Citation Linker: introduce stemming (ER #2764)
 - (R3) KB Tools: Add MySQL query interface to SFX Admin Center (ER #3090)

Hybrid Open Access

Hybrid Open Access journals require access control at the article level. Currently SFX is focused on journal level access.
What are the plans for SFX?

Knowledge Bases in Alma, SFX and Primo Central

Can you please explain the way Ex Libris handles the existence of KB's for SFX, Alma and Primo Central. There is a partial (though not full) overlap in requirements from these systems, and even some dependencies.

In what way does Ex Libris make sure all KB's are kept in sync and at the right quality level?

Will be implemented a support of more Shibboleth Identity Providers (IdP) into SFX?

Right now, there is only one IdP supported. It is placed in the configuration file "shibboleth.config".

Would be perfect, if adding of new Shibboleth IdP would be the same as editing Proxy configurations in SFX Admin Center with a list and "add new IdP" function. It would be usefull for consortia model of SFX instalations.

- Is it planned to enhance support of musical documents in SFX? There are plenty of musical databases missing in CKB as Naxos music library etc. in spite of the fact some are in Metalib. There is also completely missing category "music" in A-Z list

- Is it planned to add well know “Open Library” into SFX CKB?
- There are over 1 mil. E-books available and it is a great information source that would increase the number of free e-books dramatically

As we heard there was an discussion about enhancing functions of Authentication note in SFX menu in the past. Would be very useful to implement automatical filling of of auth note field wit a names of activated institutions for the target / object portfolio. Might be possible to implement this function?
